Legislative Council Panel on Education Follow-up to the Meeting on 3 January 2020

At the meeting on 3 January 2020, Members of the Panel on Education requested the Government to provide supplementary information regarding the agenda item of "Targeted Taught Postgraduate Programmes Fellowships Scheme" (the Scheme). The Government's reply is set out below.

<u>Criteria for selecting programmes relevant to the priority area of "Developing a</u> <u>Sustainable Environment"</u>

To prepare for the implementation of the Scheme, the University Grants Committee (UGC) has set up a task force to finalise the details of the Scheme and to assess proposals from the universities on the taught postgraduate (TPg) programmes and fellowship places. The task force is led by Sir Howard Newby, former Vice-Chancellor of the University of Liverpool in the United Kingdom, with members including overseas academics and experts who are experienced in the relevant fields and with no conflicts of interests. The task force assesses the proposed TPg programmes and the respective number of fellowships to be allocated to each programme under each priority area (including "Developing a Sustainable Environment") in accordance with the following set of criteria –

- (i) relevance to the specific priority area;
- (ii) the manpower requirements and market demand presented by the universities prove that the programme can attract meritorious students;
- (iii)the capability of the programme in nurturing talent and supporting the high value-added and diversified development of Hong Kong, as well as its social impact;
- (iv)the university's previous experience in offering relevant programmes; and
- (v) the long-term sustainability of the programme.

In February this year, the UGC announced the list of eligible programmes and the respective number of fellowship places to be allocated to each programme for the first cohort of the Scheme. Among them, five selected TPg programmes are in the priority area of "Developing a Sustainable Environment", with a total of 56 fellowship places. Details are at <u>Annex I</u>.

To gain experience and facilitate the consideration of the arrangements for the second cohort (i.e. 2021/22 academic year), the UGC will invite the universities to offer comments on the implementation arrangements of the Scheme.

Number of non-local students on postgraduate programmes who have discontinued their studies in the 2019/20 academic year

The UGC Secretariat has sought information from the UGC-funded universities on the situation of the discontinuation of studies by non-local students on postgraduate programmes in the first semester of the 2019/20 academic year. When compared with the situation in the 2018/19 academic year, no substantial increase was detected in the number of non-local students discontinuing their studies. Details are at <u>Annex II</u>. It should be noted that the decision to discontinue studies is a matter of personal choice, having regard to different reasons including employment, family, health, changing schools/institutions, financial difficulties, and academic results. The universities are unable to assess whether the cases of discontinuing studies involve the element of social events.
