Action

I. Election of Chairman and Deputy Chairman

Election of Chairman

Mr Wilson OR, Chairman in office, invited nominations for the chairmanship. Mr Gary FAN nominated Mr Andrew WAN and the nomination was seconded by Mr James TO and Mr SHIU Ka-chun. Mr Andrew WAN accepted the nomination. Mr Vincent CHENG nominated Mr Wilson OR and the nomination was seconded by Mr CHAN Hak-kan and Mr KWOK Wai-keung. Mr Wilson OR accepted the nomination.

- 2. <u>Mr James TO</u>, member of the highest precedence among those present not nominated for the office, presided over the election and called for other nominations. There was no other nomination.
- 3. <u>Mr CHAN Chi-chuen</u> suggested that the two candidates be given time to present their election platforms. <u>Mr Andrew WAN</u> and <u>Mr Wilson OR</u> made their respective presentations.
- 4. <u>Mr James TO</u> proceeded with the election and announced that voting be conducted by secret ballot. After members had cast their votes, <u>Mr James TO</u> invited Mr Gary FAN and Mr Vincent CHENG who had nominated Mr Andrew WAN and Mr Wilson OR respectively to monitor the counting of votes.
- 5. <u>Mr James TO</u> announced that eight and 25 members voted for Mr Andrew WAN and Mr Wilson OR respectively. <u>Mr TO</u> declared that Mr Wilson OR was elected Chairman of the Panel for the 2019-2020 legislative session.

Action

Election of Deputy Chairman

6. Mr Wilson OR took over the chair and invited nominations for the deputy chairmanship of the Panel. Mr Gary FAN nominated Mr Andrew WAN, and the nomination was seconded by Mr CHU Hoi-dick and Mr James TO. Mr Andrew WAN accepted the nomination. As there was no other nomination, the Chairman declared that Mr Andrew WAN was elected Deputy Chairman of the Panel for the 2019-2020 legislative session.

II. Schedule of meetings for the 2019-2020 session

7. The Chairman referred members to the proposed schedule of regular meetings of the Panel for the 2019-2020 session prepared by the Clerk, which was tabled at the meeting. Members agreed that the monthly regular meetings of the Panel would be held on the first Monday of each month at 2:30 pm, except for the meeting in April 2020 which would be held on Monday, 30 March 2020 at 2:30 pm.
