Capital Works Reserve Fund Head 710 Computerisation Subhead A007GX (Block Allocation) – New Administrative Computer Systems: 2020-21 Estimates of Expenditure

Introduction

This paper seeks Members' support for the 2020-21 Estimates under Capital Works Reserve Fund Head 710 Computerisation Subhead **A007GX** (Block Allocation) – New Administrative Computer Systems.

Background

- 2. The Finance Committee ("FC") has approved the establishment of block allocation subheads under different Heads of Expenditure of the Capital Works Reserve Fund ("CWRF"). At present, there are a total of 26 CWRF block allocation subheads, covering different types of expenditure on public works, land acquisition, capital subvention and computerisation financial ceiling of each project under Head 710 projects. The Computerisation Subhead **A007GX** (Block Allocation) New Administrative Computer Systems is \$10 million. The Financial Secretary has delegated to the Government Chief Information Officer the power to approve projects and authorise expenditure under the Block Allocation. Projects with expenditure exceeding the above ceiling should be submitted to FC for funding approval individually.
- 3. Computerisation projects with expenditures up to \$200,000 are approved by the relevant bureaux / departments ("B/Ds") and met from the operating expenses of the respective Controlling Officer's Reports under the General Revenue Account.

Computerisation Block Allocation

- 4. Each year, the Office of the Government Chief Information Officer ("OGCIO") assesses the funding requirements for Subhead **A007GX** in the following financial year having regard to the cash flow requirements of approved block vote projects, new project proposals submitted by B/Ds, anticipated new projects for various e-Government initiatives to be submitted, as well as the spending position of the Block Allocation.
- 5. In proposing new computerisation projects, B/Ds are required to observe the following guiding principles -
 - (a) support the implementation of e-Government strategies in managing and using information and communications technology and adopt e-Government service as a major mode of service provision;
 - (b) integrate e-Government services into their overall business plans and introduce service transformation and business process re-engineering in all organisational / business reviews to enhance business benefits;
 - (c) embrace a citizen-centric culture in the delivery of public services and encourage the public to adopt the most efficient, user-friendly and cost-effective channels;
 - (d) proactively identify opportunities for implementation of crossdepartment services, take ownership of these services and account for their performance / benefits;
 - (e) support the development of Hong Kong into a world-class smart city; and
 - (f) adopt the new pro-innovation procurement policy effective April 2019.
- 6. OGCIO requires B/Ds to regularly review their project timetable in light of latest progress to derive realistic cash flow requirements. This arrangement not only avoids unnecessarily locking up funds for individual projects, but enables OGCIO to deploy the relevant provisions to meet the requirements of other urgent or high priority projects.

2020-21Estimates of Expenditure

- 7. We estimate that a Block Allocation of \$1,300 million will be required under Subhead A007GX for 2020-21, which is \$180 million (or 16.1%) higher than the provision of \$1,120 million in 2019-20. A breakdown of the expenditure items for 2019-20 and 2020-21 is at Annex A. The proposed annual estimates of the Block Allocation will enable the Government to make effective use of information technology ("IT") to improve services and operational efficiency, as well as strengthen system security.
- 8. At <u>Annex B</u> are the estimated cash flow requirements of projects implemented / to be implemented in or before 2019-20 and new projects to be implemented in 2020-21. The new projects proposed under the Block Allocation can be broadly classified into the following categories –

(a) e-Government

To further enhance user experience of various e-Government services, OGCIO requires all B/Ds to adopt mobile-friendly design in developing new e-Government systems and adopt such design in all government websites by end-2020. Moreover, some government departments have adopted the Faster Payment System and common QR codes launched by the Hong Kong Monetary Authority to facilitate convenient payments of tax, rates and government rents, and water charges. This service will be extended to other government departments progressively. Some new projects include -

- (i) Enhancement of Vehicles and Drivers Licensing Integrated Data V System to support Faster Payment System (Transport Department);
- (ii) Implementation of Performing Arts Web Portal (Leisure and Cultural Services Department); and

(iii) Enhancement of Websites of Dutiable Commodities System and Road Cargo System adopting Mobile Friendly Design (Customs and Excise Department).

(b) Opening up government data and using robotic technology

We announced the new open data policy and measures to B/Ds in September 2018, requiring them to endeavour to open up their data in machine-readable formats on the Public Sector Information Portal (data.gov.hk) for free use by the public with a view to promoting innovation and research. Moreover, the Government will strengthen the use of robotic technology to enhance city management, improve people's quality of living and promote smart city development. Some new projects include -

- (i) Development of Common Interactive Data Dissemination System for Social and Economic Statistics (Census and Statistics Department);
- (ii) Online Dissemination of Airborne Light Detection and Ranging Data (Civil Engineering and Development Department); and
- (iii) Implementation of Chatbot Service on "GeoInfo Map" Website (Lands Department).

(c) Enhancing operational efficiency

Apart from the provision of public services, B/Ds will also develop and implement various IT systems to enhance internal operational efficiency and productivity, create a greener environment, and address growth in business demands. Some new projects include -

- (i) Enhancement of Tobacco and Alcohol Control Office Information System (Department of Health);
- (ii) Revamp of Food Surveillance System (Food and Environmental Hygiene Department); and

(iii) Development of Mobile Solution for Facilitating Monitoring and Patrolling Squatter Structures (Lands Department).

(d) System technology refresh

System technology refresh is an on-going task to address the problems of ageing system hardware and obsolete software, as well as leverage the next generation technology to enhance system efficiency and functionality. Moreover, the Government will adopt cloud computing to enhance agility and efficiency in meeting the growing demand of B/Ds on IT resources. Some new projects include -

- (i) Revamp of Laboratory Information Management System (Drainage Services Department);
- (ii) Upgrade of Backend System of Electronic Billing for Rates and Government Rent (Rating and Valuation Department); and
- (iii) Revamp of Online Application System for School-based Support Services (Education Bureau).

(e) Strengthening IT security

Amidst the ever-increasing number and complexity of cyber security threats, B/Ds will conduct regular security risk assessments and audits on IT systems in accordance with IT security policies and implement effective measures to guard against security threats and cyber attacks on Government IT systems. Some new projects include -

- (i) Strengthening Data Security (Buildings Department);
- (ii) Upgrade of IT Security Infrastructure and Strengthening Cyber Threat Protection (Labour Department); and

(iii) Strengthening of IT Security and IT Security Risk Assessment and Audit (Planning Department).

A list of the 267 new projects to be implemented in 2020-21 is at **Annex C**.

Submission of Funding Proposal to FC

9. If supported by the Panel, the Government will submit the 2020-21 estimates of expenditure of all block allocations under CWRF (including Subhead **A007GX**) to the Public Works Subcommittee ("PWSC") (tentatively in December 2019) and seek funding approval from FC (tentatively in January 2020).

Advice Sought

10. Members are invited to support the submission of 2020-21 estimates of expenditure for CWRF Head 710 Subhead **A007GX** (Block Allocation) – New Administrative Computer Systems to PWSC.
