Dear Mr. Yeung,

I am writing to inquire about the progress and to express the voice on behalf of the residents which I represent them as an elected member of Tuen Mun District Council.

The Highway Department has submitted a paper (LC paper No. CB(4)378/19-20(03)) to the Panel on Transport of the Legislative Council and it is scheduled to be discussed on March 20.

Project 853TH is a long awaited project which residents would like to anticipate its completion as soon as possible. Nonetheless, concerns of constructing cantilever noise barrier right outside Hong Kong Gold Coast Phase 1 is something that could not be ignored.

Residents of HKGC Phase 1 voted against the construction of such barrier back in 2014. Due to the nature of the Deed of Mutual Covenant of HKGC, such expression might possibly be deferred or have not translated into the actual plan summoned to the Panel meeting.

Drawing HMW-6853TH-SK0025 clear shows the barrier is being constructed. I am surprised that the Department may possibly overlooked such vital opinion.

It would be grateful if your Department can take the opinion of the resident into consideration and to adjust it before commencing the project later this year. I have tried to call you this morning but it has not been picked up. Should you have any follow-up questions, please do not hesitate to contact me.
