MilMill, as HK first beverage carton pulp mill, would like to express our support to MSW Charging.

As per EPD statistics, the rubbish volume has been increasing for the past years while the recycling rate has been declining. Daily, there are several thousand tons of recyclables which were valuable materials being landfilled. Take the beverage cartons as example, every day MilMill receives about 2 tons but there are totally 67 tons in the landfills. MSW Charging will definitely help to boost the recycling rate as per the experience in other countries like Taiwan and S. Korea.

The implementation of MSW Charging will help to increase lot of job opportunities not just for non-skilled workers but also highly educated one as per experience in EU.
