¹ In accordance with rule 4(c) of the House Rules, the President decides the priority of Members to ask questions at meetings for CE's Question Time and CE's Question and Answer Sessions ("Q&A Sessions"). The rule provides that at Q&A Sessions, Members who have asked the least number of questions at previous sessions within the term of the Legislative Council are given priority to ask questions. Where there are Members with equal priority, the President will have the discretion to decide whom to be called first to ask a question.

² The numbers of questions asked by Members at meetings for CE's Question Time and CE's Q&A Sessions are counted separately.

³ Including 49 questions asked by those who have ceased to be Members.
