**Minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday 5 May 2021 at 11:00 am
and Thursday 6 May 2021 at 9:00 am**

Attendance

The attendance of Members, public officers and Clerks is in the Official Record of Proceedings.

Laying of Papers on the Table of the Council

One item of subsidiary legislation laid on the Table of the Council and two other papers tabled under Rule 21(2) of the Rules of Procedure (“RoP”) were in **Appendix 1**.

Questions

Six oral questions (i.e. Questions 1 to 6) were put by the Members, and oral replies given by the public officers to the main and supplementary questions put by Members.

Written replies to Questions 7 to 22 were supplied to Members.

Government Bills

First Reading and Second Reading (debate to be adjourned)

- Mercury Control Bill : Secretary for the Environment

After the Bill was read the first time and ordered to be set down for Second Reading under RoP 53(3), the public officer moved the Second Reading of the Bill. The question on the Second Reading of the Bill was proposed. In accordance with RoP 54(4), the debate was adjourned and the Bill was referred to the House Committee.

Second Reading (debate to resume), consideration by committee of the whole Council and Third Reading

- Mainland Judgments in Matrimonial and Family Cases (Reciprocal Recognition and Enforcement) Bill : Secretary for Justice

The Second Reading debate on the Bill resumed. After Members and the public officer had spoken, the question on the Second Reading of the Bill was put and agreed to. The Bill was read the second time and committed to a committee of the whole Council.

The Council became committee of the whole Council and considered the Bill. The provisions of the Bill and amendments thereto were debated and voted in accordance with the relevant debate and voting arrangements and the relevant provisions of RoP. During the consideration of the Bill, the following questions were put:

The question on the public officer's motion that the report made under RoP 58(12) be adopted by this Council was proposed, put and agreed to. The Bill was ordered to be set down for Third Reading under RoP 59. The question on the Third Reading of the Bill was proposed, put and agreed to. The Bill was read the third time and passed.

Government Motions

The Chief Secretary for Administration moved his first motion. The question on the first motion was proposed. A joint debate on the two motions was held. After conclusion of the joint debate, the following questions were put:

The Second Reading debate on the Bill resumed. After Members and the public officer had spoken, the question on the Second Reading of the Bill was put and agreed to. The Bill was read the second time and committed to a committee of the whole Council.

The Council became committee of the whole Council and considered the Bill. The question that clauses 1 to 3 stand part of the Bill was proposed. After Hon Alice MAK had spoken, the question that clauses 1 to 3 stand part of the Bill was put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed. Hon Alice MAK reported the Bill to the Council without amendment. The question on Hon Alice MAK's motion that the report made under RoP 58(12) be adopted by this Council was proposed, put and agreed to. The Bill was ordered to be set down for Third Reading under RoP 59. The question on the Third Reading of the Bill was proposed, put and agreed to. The Bill was read the third time and passed.
