Second Reading (debate to resume), consideration by committee of the whole Council and Third Reading

- Legislative Council (Disciplinary Sanctions and Remote Sitting) (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2021 : Chief Secretary for Administration

The Second Reading debate on the Bill resumed. After Members and the public officer had spoken, the question on the Second Reading of the Bill was put and agreed to. The Bill was read the second time and committed to a committee of the whole Council.

The Council became committee of the whole Council and considered the Bill. The question that clauses 1 to 11 stand part of the Bill was proposed, put and agreed to.

The Council then resumed. The public officer reported the Bill to the Council without amendment. The question on the public officer's motion that the report made under RoP 58(12) be adopted by this Council was proposed, put and agreed to. The Bill was ordered to be set down for Third Reading under RoP 59. The question on the Third Reading of the Bill was proposed, put and agreed to. The Bill was read the third time and passed.

- Supplementary Appropriation (2020-2021) Bill : Secretary for Financial Services and the Treasury

The Second Reading debate on the Bill resumed. The question on the Second Reading of the Bill was put and agreed to. The Bill was read the second time and committed to a committee of the whole Council.

The Council became committee of the whole Council and considered the Bill. The question that clauses 1 and 2, and the Schedule stand part of the Bill was proposed, put and agreed to.

- Dangerous Goods (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill 2021 : Secretary for Security
