**Council meeting on 20, 21 and 22 January 2021**

**Motion of Thanks**

Further to LC Paper No. CB(3) 278/20-21 issued on 11 January 2021, I set out below the procedure for dealing with the Motion of Thanks for Members' information:

- (a) Hon Starry LEE moves the motion (the motion mover has 15-minute speaking time for moving the motion and making the reply);
- (b) the President proposes the question on the motion;
- (c) the arrangement for Members to speak on the motion is as follows:
  - (i) Members' speeches in a debate session should be confined to the policy areas specified for that session. The grouping of policy areas for this debate is in the **Appendix**; and
  - (ii) **each Member** (including the motion mover) **may speak once in each of the two debate sessions**, subject to the **total** speaking time limit of **30 minutes**;
- (d) after Members have spoken in each debate session, there will be a 10-minute suspension of the meeting if the public officers ("POs") attending that session require a break to co-ordinate their response to the Council. If POs consider the break not necessary, the President may exercise discretion not to suspend the meeting;

- (e) if three or more POs speak in a debate session, their speaking time limit is calculated on the basis of 15-minute speaking time for each PO. As shown in the Appendix, the total speaking time limit for POs in the two debate sessions is as follows:
- **first session:** not more than 2 hours 45 minutes (11 POs in total); and
  - **second session:** not more than 2 hours 15 minutes (9 POs in total);
- (f) at the end of the first debate session and before the start of the second debate session, Members will be informed of the balance of their speaking time; and
- (g) after POs have spoken in the second debate session, the President calls upon Hon Starry LEE to reply, and then puts to vote the question on the motion.
