Outcome of consultation on proposals to amend the Finance Committee Procedure, the Establishment Subcommittee Procedure and the Public Works Subcommittee Procedure – First batch of proposed amendments

Further to LC Paper No. FC 202/20-21 issued on 29 July 2021 inviting members to give views on the proposals to amend the Finance Committee Procedure, the Establishment Subcommittee Procedure and the Public Works Subcommittee Procedure ("first batch of proposed amendments") (i.e. Appendix I to FC202/20-21), this circular informs members of the outcome of the consultation.

- 2. Members are invited to note that 39 members, out of a total of 41 (excluding the Chairman), responded to the consultation. The consultation results are presented in the **Appendix**. The results show that an overwhelming majority of members support all the proposals in the first batch of proposed amendments.¹
- 3. With reference to the set of procedures under the resolution made and passed by the Finance Committee ("FC") on 13 January 2018 for dealing with members' motions to amend the said procedures and relevant precedent cases, the Chairman has directed that the proposed amendments will be presented in the form of a motion for FC's consideration at a meeting, and the motion will be moved by the Deputy Chairman (who has indicated concurrence).

¹ Two options (i.e. Options 1 and 2) are proposed under item 5 of the proposals and an overwhelming majority of members support Option 2.

4. Members are further invited to note that the Chairman will consult members on further proposals to amend the said procedures in areas concerning mainly the membership and election of the chairman and deputy chairman of FC and its subcommittees ("the second batch of proposed amendments"). The Chairman intends to deal with the first and second batches of proposed amendments in one go at a future FC meeting. Members will be notified of the meeting arrangements in due course.

¹³ of these members also suggested that "if an item is endorsed by a subcommittee, it is assumed that the item endorsed does not require further discussion by FC unless not less than five FC members jointly request for further discussion in FC. Such a request should reach the Clerk not less than two clear days before the FC meeting concerned, but the Chairman may allow shorter notice. Upon receipt of a joint request made by members, the Chairman needs not seek FC's agreement to the request and may refer the item endorsed by the subcommittee to FC for further discussion". Another member considered that "the existing procedures are working well and there is no need for any amendment. Moreover, if the proposed amendment to "specify the power of the Chairman to set time limits on the consideration of agenda items or motions" is adopted, it will be sufficient to ensure the orderly and efficient use of FC's meeting time".
