Report No. 11/20-21 of the House Committee on Consideration of Subsidiary Legislation and Other Instruments

Purpose

This report gives the outcome of the consideration of the House Committee on subsidiary legislation the period for amendment of which will expire at the Council meeting of 3 February 2021.

3. At the House Committee meeting on 8 January 2021, the House Committee agreed that items (1) to (3) should be studied by the Subcommittee on Subsidiary Legislation Relating to the Prevention and Control of Disease which had been formed at the House Committee meeting on 16 October 2020. The Subcommittee made a verbal report at the House Committee meeting on 15 January 2021 its deliberations on these three items and one other item of subsidiary legislation tabled in Council on 9 December 2020, and provided Members with a written report vide LC Paper No. CB(2)687/20-21 on 20 January 2021.

4. A subcommittee was proposed to be formed to study items (4) to (7) in detail at the House Committee meeting on 8 January 2021. Since only one Member has signified to join the proposed subcommittee by the deadline for signification of membership, it cannot be formed by virtue of rules 21(b) and 26(f) of the House Rules.

5. In respect of items (8) to (10), at the House Committee meeting on 8 January 2021, Members considered it not necessary to form any subcommittee to study these three items of subsidiary legislation. Regarding items (11) to (14), Members were consulted on whether they considered it necessary to form a subcommittee(s) to study any of these four items of subsidiary legislation vide LC Paper No. CB(2)690/20-21 issued on 21 January 2021. Since no Members have so indicated by the expiry of the deadline for reply, the House Committee did not form any subcommittee to study these four items of subsidiary legislation.

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Note: At the House Committee meeting on 8 January 2021, the House Committee agreed that the Prevention and Control of Disease (Use of Vaccines) Regulation (L.N. 258/2020) should be studied by the Subcommittee on Subsidiary Legislation Relating to the Prevention and Control of Disease which had been formed at the House Committee meeting on 16 October 2020. The Council passed at its meeting of 27 January 2021 a resolution moved by Dr Hon CHIANG Lai-wan, Chairman of the Subcommittee, to extend the period for amending this item of subsidiary legislation to the Council meeting of 24 February 2021.
