## Report No. 5/20-21 of the House Committee on Consideration of Subsidiary Legislation and Other Instruments

## **Purpose**

This report gives the outcome of the consideration of the House Committee on subsidiary legislation the period for amendment of which will expire at the Council meeting of 9 December 2020.

## Subsidiary legislation considered

2. The House Committee has considered the following items of subsidiary legislation:

3. The House Committee formed a subcommittee to study item (1) in detail at its meeting on 23 October 2020. At the House Committee meeting on 20 November 2020, the House Committee noted that following the latest changes in the Legislative Council Membership, the membership of the Subcommittee had reduced to less than three Members. The House Committee considered it not necessary for the Subcommittee to continue operation for scrutiny of item (1), and agreed that the Subcommittee be dissolved.

4. At the House Committee meeting on 23 October 2020, the House Committee agreed that item (2) should be studied by the Subcommittee on Subsidiary Legislation Relating to the Prevention and Control of Disease which had been formed at the House Committee meeting on 16 October 2020. The Subcommittee made a verbal report at the House Committee meeting on 27 November 2020 in respect of item (2) and 21 other items of subsidiary legislation tabled in Council between 15 July 2020 and 14 October 2020, and provided Members with a written report vide LC Paper No. CB(2)407/20-21 on 2 December 2020.
