Report No. 7/20-21 of the House Committee on Consideration of Subsidiary Legislation and Other Instruments

Purpose

This report gives the outcome of the consideration of the House Committee on subsidiary legislation the period for amendment of which will expire at the Council meeting of 6 January 2021.

- 3. At the House Committee meeting on 20 November 2020, the House Committee agreed that item (1) should be studied by the Subcommittee on Subsidiary Legislation Relating to the Prevention and Control of Disease which had been formed at the House Committee meeting on 16 October 2020. The Subcommittee provided Members with a written report on 29 December 2020 vide LC Paper No. CB(2)563/20-21.
- 4. A subcommittee was proposed to be formed to study items (2) and (3) in detail at the House Committee meeting on 11 December 2020. Since only one Member has signified to join the proposed subcommittee by the deadline for signification of membership, it cannot be formed by virtue of rules 21(b) and 26(f) of the House Rules.
- 5. In respect of items (4) and (5), the House Committee considered it not necessary to form any subcommittee to study these two items of subsidiary legislation.

Note: At the House Committee meeting on 11 December 2020, the House Committee agreed that the following 11 items of subsidiary legislation should be studied by the Subcommittee on Subsidiary Legislation Relating to the Prevention and Control of Disease which had been formed at the House Committee meeting on 16 October 2020. The President has given permission for Dr Hon CHIANG Lai-wan, Chairman of the Subcommittee, to move a proposed resolution at the Council meeting of 6 January 2021 to extend the period for amending these 11 items of subsidiary legislation to the Council meeting of 27 January 2021.
