Report No. 14/20-21 of the House Committee on Consideration of Subsidiary Legislation and Other Instruments

Purpose

This report gives the outcome of the consideration of the House Committee on subsidiary legislation the period for amendment of which will expire at the Council meeting of 24 March 2021.

3. At the respective House Committee meetings on 19 and 26 February 2021, the House Committee agreed that item (3) and items (8) to (14) should be studied by the Subcommittee on Subsidiary Legislation Relating to the Prevention and Control of Disease which had been formed at the House Committee meeting on 16 October 2020. The Subcommittee made a verbal report at the House Committee meeting on 12 March 2021, and provided Members with a written report vide LC Paper No. CB(4)653/20-21 on 17 March 2021.

4. In respect of items (1), (2), (4) to (7) and (15) to (17), the House Committee considered it not necessary to form any subcommittee to study these nine items of subsidiary legislation.

Note: The House Committee formed a subcommittee to study the Public Revenue Protection (Revenue) Order 2021 (L.N. 31/2021) at its meeting on 26 February 2021. On 17 March 2021, Hon CHAN Kin-por, Chairman of the Subcommittee, gave notice to move a proposed resolution at the Council meeting of 24 March 2021 to extend the period for amending this item of subsidiary legislation to the Council meeting of 5 May 2021. At the House Committee meeting on 19 March 2021, Members considered it necessary to form a Bills Committee to study the Revenue (First Registration Tax and Licence Fees for Motor Vehicles) Bill 2021 in detail. As the contents of the Bill and of this item of subsidiary legislation were identical, Members further agreed that members of the Subcommittee would become members of the Bills Committee and that it was not necessary for the Subcommittee to continue operation.
