I. Election of Chairman

As Dr LEUNG was nominated for the office, <u>Mrs Regina IP</u>, the member who had the highest precedence among the members not nominated for the office, presided over the election of chairman. There being no other nomination, <u>Dr LEUNG</u> was elected as the Chairman of the Subcommittee. <u>Dr LEUNG</u> then took the chair.

3. <u>Members</u> agreed that there was no need to elect a Deputy Chairman.
