In the absence of the Chairman at this meeting, the Subcommittee agreed to elect a Chairman to act at this meeting. Mr Abraham SHEK, the member with the highest precedence among those present at the meeting, presided over the election. Mr SHEK invited nominations for the acting chairmanship. Mr LAU Kwok-fan nominated Ir Dr LO Wai-kwok and the nomination was seconded by Mr Abraham SHEK. Ir Dr LO accepted the nomination. There being no other nomination, Ir Dr LO Wai-kwok was declared Chairman to act at this meeting. Ir Dr LO then took over the chair.

2. <u>Members</u> noted that as agreed at the last meeting on 3 November 2020, the Chairman of the Subcommittee gave a notice to move a motion at the Council meeting of 11 November 2020 to extend the scrutiny period of the seven pieces of subsidiary legislation relating to fee waiving or concession measures for the construction sector (L.N. 180 to L.N. 185 and L.N. 197 of 2020) ("seven pieces of subsidiary legislation") to the Council meeting of 2 December 2020. As the motion was not moved at the Council meeting of 11 November 2020, the scrutiny period of the seven pieces of subsidiary legislation had expired at the said Council meeting.

3. <u>Members</u> also noted that as agreed at the meeting on 3 November 2020, a notice was posted on the website of the Legislative Council and letters were issued to the 18 District Councils on 4 November 2020 to invite written submissions on the seven pieces of subsidiary legislation. By the submission deadline on 11 November 2020, no written submission was received.
