Extension of scrutiny period

- 3. <u>Members</u> noted that among the 22 items of subsidiary legislation under the study of the Subcommittee, the period for amending three of them, namely the Prevention and Control of Disease (Prohibition on Group Gathering) (Amendment) (No. 7) Regulation 2020 (L.N. 141 of 2020), the Prevention and Control of Disease (Regulation of Cross-boundary Conveyances and Travellers) Regulation, (L.N 142 of 2020) and the Prevention and Control of Disease (Wearing of Mask) (Public Transport) Regulation (L.N. 143 of 2020) had expired at the Council meeting of 21 October 2020.
- 4. <u>Members</u> further noted that the deadline for amending the first 18 of the following 19 subsidiary legislation items would be the Council meeting of 11 November 2020, and the deadline for amending the remaining one would be the Council meeting of 18 November 2020:

- 5. <u>Members</u> agreed that two proposed resolutions should be moved at the relevant Council meetings to extend the scrutiny period of the subsidiary legislation items listed under items (a) to (r) above to the Council meeting of 2 December 2020, and to extend the scrutiny period of the subsidiary legislation item listed under item (s) above to the Council meeting of 9 December 2020. <u>Members</u> noted that if the two proposed resolutions were passed, the deadline for giving notice of amendment to the subsidiary legislation items listed under items (a) to (r) above would be 25 November 2020, and the deadline for giving notice of amendment to the subsidiary legislation item listed under item (s) above would be 2 December 2020.
- 6. <u>Members</u> agreed to group the 22 items of subsidiary legislation according to the relevant chapter numbers to facilitate the scrutiny work of the Subcommittee.
- 7. <u>The Chairman</u> advised that members would be informed of the future meeting arrangements in due course.
- 8. There being no other business, the meeting ended at 9:19 am.
