**List of follow-up actions required of the Administration
arising from the discussion at the meeting on 16 November 2020**

The Administration was requested to:

- (a) advise the respective average daily number of persons arriving in Hong Kong who satisfied the criteria and were exempted from the compulsory quarantine requirements under the Compulsory Quarantine of Certain Persons Arriving at Hong Kong Regulation (Cap. 599C) and the Compulsory Quarantine of Persons Arriving at Hong Kong from Foreign Places Regulation (Cap. 599E) in each month since the introduction of the exemption arrangement, with breakdown by their last stayed places and the boundary control points concerned; and
- (b) in respect of the prevailing arrangement that all persons arriving at Hong Kong via the Hong Kong International Airport from any places outside China or who had stayed in any places outside China during the 14 days before the date of the person's arrival (except for exempted persons under the Compulsory Quarantine of Certain Persons Arriving at Hong Kong from Foreign Places Regulation), who did not have any symptoms and had passed temperature checks upon entry, would be subject to 14-day compulsory quarantine at hotels, consider the following suggestions from members:
 - (i) making it a mandatory requirement that guestrooms for confinees and non-confinees had to be separated in different floors; and
 - (ii) making it a mandatory requirement that minor confinees under the age of 18 years had to be accompanied by an adult in the guestroom at all times during the quarantine period.
