

**Subcommittee on Subsidiary Legislation

**List of follow-up actions required of the Administration
arising from the discussion at the meeting on 12 January 2021
in respect of L.N. 251 and L.N. 259 to L.N. 261 of 2020**

The Administration was requested to:

- (a) in respect of the compulsory testing notices issued under the Prevention and Control of Disease (Compulsory Testing for Certain Persons) Regulation (Cap. 599J) and published in the Gazette on 30 and 31 December 2020 that persons who had been present on any of the specified premises in any capacity for more than two hours at any time during the specified periods had to undergo a polymerase chain reaction-based nucleic acid test for the coronavirus disease 2019 ("COVID-19") ("the specified test") by 4 January 2021, advise the number of persons who had failed to undergo the specified test in compliance with the requirement under the relevant notices and the follow-up actions taken by the Administration against these persons (including the last required date(s) for undergoing the specified test (if applicable) and whether any prosecution had been instituted); and
- (b) advise the number of confirmed cases of COVID-19 among persons who were in transit at the Hong Kong International Airport since 2020 and the mechanism for the handling of any such cases.
