	Chairman Admin	Members noted the two written submissions received by the Subcommittee [LC Paper Nos. CB(2)1411/20-21(01) and (02)] and the Administration's consolidated response to issues raised in the written submissions [LC Paper No. CB(2)1411/20-21(03)].		
		On the inclusion of eligible routes of residents' service under the Government Public Transport Fare Concession Scheme for the Elderly and Eligible Persons with Disabilities ("the Fare Concession Scheme"), the Administration advised that it would advance the start of the preparatory work for the above to September 2021 on the premise that the preparatory work for the implementation of the committed enhancement measures (i.e. the lowering of the eligible age to 60 and extension of the coverage to red minibuses, kaitos and tramways with effect from 27 February 2022) would not be affected. Given that it would take about 12 months for the Administration to complete the necessary initial preparatory work, it was anticipated that the eligible routes of residents' service would be included in the Fare Concession Scheme starting from September 2022 the earliest.		
		The Chairman remarked that to his understanding, about 66 routes of residents' service that had joined the Public Transport Fare Subsidy Scheme should meet the three requirements as set out in paragraph 3 of LC Paper No. CB(2)1411/20-21(03) for joining the Fare Concession Scheme. Referring to the requirement that operators of individual routes of residents' service that were interested in joining the Fare Concession Scheme had to prove that there was no direct and parallel public transport alternatives for the route concerned, the Chairman asked whether the Administration would conduct a survey to take a snapshot of the current situation, with priority given to the 66-odd routes. The Administration advised that at present, the Transport Department ("TD") had approved more than 300 routes of residents' service in the territory. TD would conduct a survey on all these routes and examine whether individual routes could meet the requirements for joining the Fare Concession Scheme.
