2021 Tariff Review

2021 Net Tariff will stay at 121.8 ¢/unit, same as 2020, with breakdown as follows:


Tariff Components Unit: HK¢/kWh	2021	2020	Change
Basic Tariff	93.7	92.2	+1.5
Fuel Cost Adjustment	28.1	30.8	-2.7
Total Tariff	121.8	123.0	-1.2
Rent and Rates Special Rebate	-	-1.2	+1.2
Net Tariff	121.8	121.8	Freeze

2020 Rent & Rates Special Rebate at 1.2¢/unit will cease to apply in 2021

Carbon intensity of electricity reduced significantly by 20%, to below 0.4 kg/unit. Comparable to average of OECD countries




Reliable Supply at Reasonable Tariff

Unplanned customer minutes lost per year






