Sports and recreation facility projects (Town Park in Area 68, Tseung Kwan O, and Kwai Chung Park)

In the Policy Address in January 2017, the Government announced the Five-year Plan for Sports and Recreation Facilities ("the Five-year Plan") to launch 26 projects, involving a provision of \$20 billion, before 2022 to develop new and improve existing district sports and recreation facilities. In addition, under the Five-year Plan, the Administration will conduct technical feasibility studies for another 15 sports and recreation facility projects to prepare for their implementation in the future. The list of projects under the Five-year Plan is in the **Appendix**. The projects of "Town Park in Area 68, Tseung Kwan O" (previously known as "Town Park in Area 66 and 68, Tseung Kwan O") and "Kwai Chung Park" are amongst the 26 projects under the Five-year Plan (i.e. items 23 and 21 of the list in the Appendix).

- 2. As at December 2020, out of the 26 projects, the Finance Committee has approved the funding applications for 16 projects (i.e. items 1-16 of the list in the Appendix), involving an amount of about \$6.3 billion. The pre-construction activities/construction works have been commenced for 11 projects, with the remaining to commence within 2020 or in early 2021.
- 3. The Administration will consult the Panel on Home Affairs on the funding proposals in respect of "Town Park in Area 68, Tseung Kwan O" and "Kwai Chung Park" projects at the next meeting on 8 February 2021.

¹ Projects with approved funding from the Legislative Council will provide three heated swimming pools and 11 open spaces (including two five-a-side football pitches, four tennis courts, three basketball courts, two lawn bowling greens and two cycling grounds) as well as implement the pre-construction activities for one amenity complex (comprising sports centre and swimming pool) and the redevelopment of one sports ground.
