Action

I. Election of Chairman and Deputy Chairman
(Appendices III and IV to LC Paper No. CB(2)8/20-21)

Election of Chairman

Mr Vincent CHENG, the incumbent Chairman, called for nominations for the chairmanship of the Panel for the 2020-2021 session.

2. Mr LUK Chung-hung was nominated by Mr KWOK Wai-keung and the nomination was seconded by Mr Steven HO. Mr LUK Chung-hung accepted the nomination.

3. Mr LEUNG Yiu-chung was nominated by Dr KWOK Ka-ki and the nomination was seconded by Mr Alvin YEUNG. Mr LEUNG Yiu-chung accepted the nomination.

4. Dr Fernando CHEUNG was nominated by Dr KWOK Ka-ki and the nomination was seconded by Mr Alvin YEUNG. Dr Fernando CHEUNG accepted the nomination.

5. Prof Joseph LEE was nominated by Ms Claudia MO and the nomination was seconded by Mr Alvin YEUNG. As Prof Joseph LEE was absent, Ms Claudia MO confirmed that the nomination was accepted by Prof Joseph LEE.

6. Mr James TO was nominated by Ms Claudia MO and the nomination was seconded by Mr Alvin YEUNG. Mr James TO accepted the nomination.

7. Mr IP Kin-yuen was nominated by Dr KWOK Ka-ki and the nomination was seconded by Mr Alvin YEUNG. Mr IP Kin-yuen accepted the nomination.

8. Mr Dennis KWOK was nominated by Mr Andrew WAN and the nomination was seconded by Mr Alvin YEUNG. Mr Dennis KWOK accepted the nomination.

9. Mr Andrew WAN was nominated by Mr HUI Chi-fung and the nomination was seconded by Mr Alvin YEUNG. Mr Andrew WAN accepted the nomination.

10. Mr HUI Chi-fung was nominated by Ms Claudia MO and the nomination was seconded by Mr Alvin YEUNG. Mr HUI Chi-fung accepted the nomination.

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11. Mr WU Chi-wai was nominated by Ms Claudia MO and the nomination was seconded by Mr Alvin YEUNG. Mr WU Chi-wai accepted the nomination.

12. Dr Helena WONG was nominated by Dr Fernando CHEUNG and the nomination was seconded by Mr Alvin YEUNG. Dr Helena WONG accepted the nomination.

13. Mr Charles MOK was nominated by Dr KWOK Ka-ki and the nomination was seconded by Mr Alvin YEUNG. Mr Charles MOK accepted the nomination.

14. Mr SHIU Ka-chun was nominated by Mr HUI Chi-fung and the nomination was seconded by Mr Alvin YEUNG. As Mr SHIU Ka-chun was absent, Mr HUI Chi-fung confirmed that the nomination was accepted by Mr SHIU Ka-chun.

15. As there was no other nomination, Mr Vincent CHENG said that the nomination procedure was completed and a total of 13 valid nominations were made. He then announced a vote by secret ballot. The result of the vote was that 23 members voted for Mr LUK Chung-hung and 17 members voted for Mr Charles MOK. Mr Vincent CHENG declared Mr LUK Chung-hung elected as the Chairman of the Panel for the 2020-2021 session. Mr LUK Chung-hung then took the chair.

Election of Deputy Chairman

16. Owing to time constraint, the Chairman suggested and members agreed that the election of the Deputy Chairman of the Panel for the 2020-2021 session would be conducted at the next meeting.

II. Schedule of meetings for the 2020-2021 session

17. Members agreed that regular meetings of the Panel would normally be held on the third Tuesday of each month at 4:30 pm. As the third Tuesday of February 2021 was the day immediately after the Chinese New Year holidays, members agreed that the regular meeting in February 2021 would be rescheduled for 10:45 am on 18 February 2021.

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III. Items for discussion at the next meeting

(Appendices V and VI to LC Paper No. CB(2)8/20-21)

Regular meeting in November 2020

18. Members agreed that the following items proposed by the Administration be discussed at the next regular meeting on 17 November 2020 at 4:30 pm:

- (a) Pilot rehabilitation programme for employees injured at work; and
- (b) Creation of one permanent post of Chief Labour Officer (D1) in the Labour Department to take forward various new measures to enhance statutory maternity leave.

19. The Chairman said that he and Mr KWOK Wai-keung had proposed in a joint letter (LC Paper No. CB(2)1475/19-20(01)) that a subcommittee be formed under the Panel to study the setting up of an unemployment assistance system in Hong Kong. Members agreed that the proposal would be considered at the next regular meeting in November 2020.

20. The Chairman further said that a joint letter from Mr Andrew WAN and Mr HUI Chi-fung suggesting the Panel to discuss issues relating to the Work Orientation and Placement Scheme would be circulated to members for reference after the meeting.
