Subcommittee on Issues Relating to the Silver Age Card

**List of follow-up actions required of the Administration
arising from the discussion at the meeting on 26 February 2021**

The Administration was requested to provide a Strength-Weakness-Opportunity-Threat Analysis in relation to the welfare benefits of persons aged 60 to 64 based on the following areas of concern set out in the work plan of the Subcommittee as agreed by the Panel on Welfare Services on 11 May 2020:

- (a) feasible measures and implementation timetable for introducing the Silver Age Card;
- (b) welfare measures currently provided for members of the public aged between 60 and 64;
- (c) living conditions of members of the public aged between 60 and 64 under the poverty line;
- (d) retirement or employment status of members of the public aged between 60 and 64;
- (e) health conditions of members of the public aged between 60 and 64 and overview of their average medical expenses; and
- (f) the positive impacts to be brought about by the consumption patterns of members of the public aged between 60 and 64 and the Silver Age products on the economy of Hong Kong.
