**Shipping and Port Control (Amendment) Regulation
2021**

(Made by the Chief Executive in Council under section 80 of the
Shipping and Port Control Ordinance (Cap. 313))

1. Commencement

This Regulation comes into operation on 1 October 2021.

2. Shipping and Port Control Regulations amended

The Shipping and Port Control Regulations (Cap. 313 sub.
leg. A) are amended as set out in sections 3 and 4.

3. Regulations 52A and 52B repealed

Regulations 52A and 52B—

Repeal the regulations.

4. Regulation 52C added

Before regulation 53—

Add

**“52C. Port facilities and light dues not payable between October
2021 and September 2022**

- (1) Despite regulations 49 and 52, no port facilities and light dues are payable for the use of port facilities during the period from 1 October 2021 to 30 September 2022 (both dates inclusive).
- (2) This regulation expires at midnight on 30 September 2022.”.

Explanatory Note

This Regulation amends the Shipping and Port Control Regulations (Cap. 313 sub. leg. A) (*principal Regulations*) to extend the concessions introduced by the Shipping and Port Control (Amendment) Regulation 2020 (L.N. 167 of 2020) so that no port facilities and light dues are payable for the use of port facilities by vessels entering the waters of Hong Kong during the period from October 2021 to September 2022.

2. This Regulation also repeals regulations 52A and 52B of the principal Regulations that are spent.
