Report No. 11/2022 of the House Committee on Consideration of Subsidiary Legislation and Other Instruments

Purpose

This report gives the outcome of the consideration of the House Committee on subsidiary legislation the period for amendment of which will expire at the Council meeting of 15 June 2022.

- 3. At the House Committee meeting on 29 April 2022, members noted that the Legal Services Division was scrutinizing the legal and drafting aspects of items (1) and (2) relating to the prevention and control of COVID-19, and a further report would be made, if necessary. The further report prepared by the Legal Services Division on these two items of subsidiary legislation was issued to members of the House Committee in the morning of 13 May 2022. At its meeting held in the afternoon of the same day, the House Committee agreed that these two items of subsidiary legislation should be studied in detail by the Subcommittee on Subsidiary Legislation Relating to the Prevention and Control of Disease which had been formed at the House Committee meeting on 25 February 2022. The Subcommittee made a verbal report at the House Committee meeting on 27 May 2022, and provided Members with a written report vide LC Paper No. CB(4)506/2022 on 8 June 2022.
- 4. The House Committee formed a subcommittee to study item (3) in detail at its meeting on 29 April 2022. The Subcommittee reported its deliberations at the House Committee meeting on 27 May 2022 vide LC Paper No. CB(1)300/2022.
