Registration of Persons (Application for New Identity Cards) Order 2018 (Amendment) Order 2022

(Made by the Secretary for Security under section 7B(1) of the Registration of Persons Ordinance (Cap. 177))

1. Commencement

This Order comes into operation on 4 April 2022.

2. Registration of Persons (Application for New Identity Cards) Order 2018 amended

The Registration of Persons (Application for New Identity Cards) Order 2018 (Cap. 177 sub. leg. J) is amended as set out in sections 3 and 4.

3. Section 5 amended (applications by certain public officers)

After section 5(4)—

Add

“(5) For the purposes of section 4, specified period includes the period from 4 April 2022 to 10 June 2022, in relation to a member of the seventh term Legislative Council whose target identity card shows the following year of birth—1992, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1996, 1997, 1998, 1999 or 2000.”.

4. Schedule 2 amended (years of birth and specified periods)

“1955 or 1956

Explanatory Note

This Order amends Schedule 2 to the Registration of Persons (Application for New Identity Cards) Order 2018 (Cap. 177 sub. leg. J) (*principal Order*) to specify the periods within which holders of target identity cards that show 1954 or any year before, 1989, 1990, 1991, 1992, 1993, 1994, 1995, 1996, 1997, 1998, 1999 or 2000 as the year of birth must apply for new identity cards.

2. The Order also amends section 5 of the principal Order to provide certain members of the seventh term Legislative Council with an option to apply for new identity cards within the period from 4 April 2022 to 10 June 2022.
