

**L.N. 70 of 2022**

**Shipping and Port Control (Amendment) Regulation 2022**

(Made by the Chief Executive in Council under section 80 of the Shipping and Port Control Ordinance (Cap. 313))

**1. Commencement**

This Regulation comes into operation on 1 October 2022.

**2. Shipping and Port Control Regulations amended**

The Shipping and Port Control Regulations (Cap. 313 sub. leg. A) are amended as set out in sections 3 and 4.

**3. Regulation 52C repealed (port facilities and light dues not payable between October 2021 and September 2022)**

Regulation 52C—

**Repeal the regulation.**

**4. Regulation 52D added**

Before regulation 53—

**Add**

**“52D. Port facilities and light dues not payable between October 2022 and September 2023**

(1) Despite regulations 49 and 52, no port facilities and light dues are payable for the use of port facilities during the period from 1 October 2022 to 30 September 2023 (both dates inclusive).

(2) This regulation expires at midnight on 30 September 2023.”.

### **Explanatory Note**

This Regulation amends the Shipping and Port Control Regulations (Cap. 313 sub. leg. A) (*principal Regulations*) to extend the concessions introduced by the Shipping and Port Control (Amendment) Regulation 2021 (L.N. 175 of 2021) so that no port facilities and light dues are payable for the use of port facilities by vessels entering the waters of Hong Kong during the period from October 2022 to September 2023.

2. This Regulation also repeals regulation 52C of the principal Regulations. That provision expires when this Regulation comes into operation.
