**Merchant Shipping (Prevention and Control of Pollution)
(Fees) (Amendment) Regulation 2022**

Explanatory Note

This Regulation amends the Merchant Shipping (Prevention and Control of Pollution) (Fees) Regulation (Cap. 413 sub. leg. L) to provide for the fees payable in respect of certain certificates issued under—

- (a) the Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Oil Pollution) Regulations (Cap. 413 sub. leg. A);
- (b) the Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Pollution by Sewage) Regulation (Cap. 413 sub. leg. K); and
- (c) the Merchant Shipping (Prevention of Air Pollution) Regulation (Cap. 413 sub. leg. P).
