Public Works Programme Item No. 469CL – Kai Tak Development – Infrastructure at North Apron Area of Kai Tak Airport

Follow-up Actions of the Meeting held on 27 June 2023

At the meeting of the Panel on Development held on 27 June 2023, a Member requested the Government to provide the following further information in respect of the agenda item:

- (a) the timetable for the completion/anticipated completion of the various landscaped and leisure facilities (including but not limited to open spaces OS3b, OS4, OS5, OS6 and OS6a) under construction and proposed to be built in Kai Tak Development for use by the public. Please provide the information in itemized form, accompanied by the relevant location plans and/or layout plans for illustration; and
- (b) a list of government departments responsible for managing the aforesaid landscaped and leisure facilities.
- 2. After consultation with the relevant bureaux/departments, the relevant information is set out in the **Annex** and the **Location Plan** for Members' reference.

<u>Annex</u>

About one-third of the land in the Kai Tak Development (KTD) (about 100 hectares) is planned as open space with a view to providing open space facilities and landscaped greenery for the local and neighbouring residents to tie in with the various developments in the area. In view of the scale of the KTD, the development works will be taken forward by different departments/units in phases and according to priorities. The development of various open spaces in the area will take into account factors such as population growth in the area, the development pace of neighbouring infrastructures and supporting facilities, as well as the needs of the public and the community. The Kai Tak Office of the Civil Engineering and Development Department (CEDD) is actively coordinating the planning and implementation of open spaces and other infrastructure projects in the KTD.

The anticipated completion/opening dates of proposed major open spaces in the KTD under construction and proposed to be built, and responsible parties for managing the open spaces are as follows.
