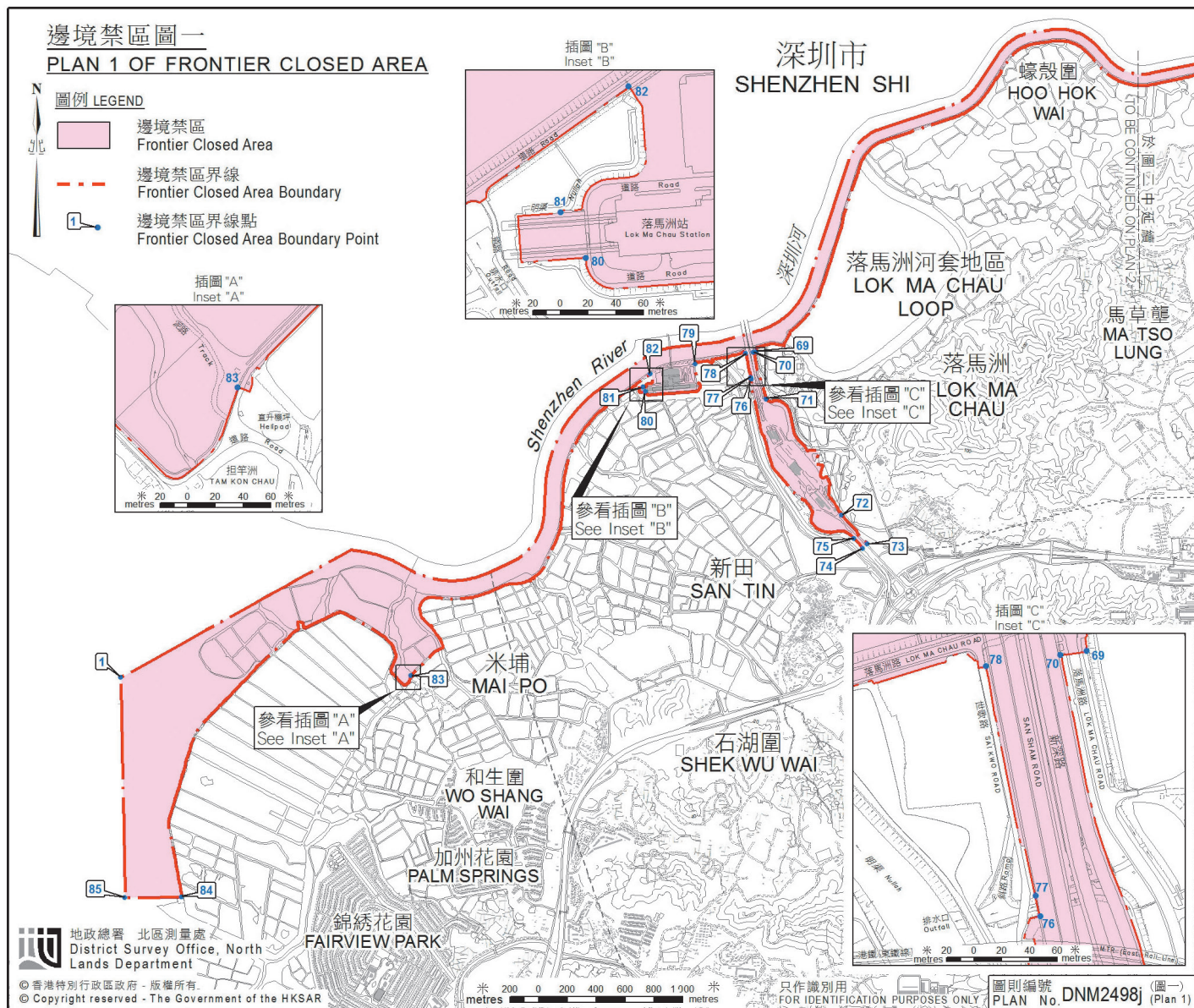

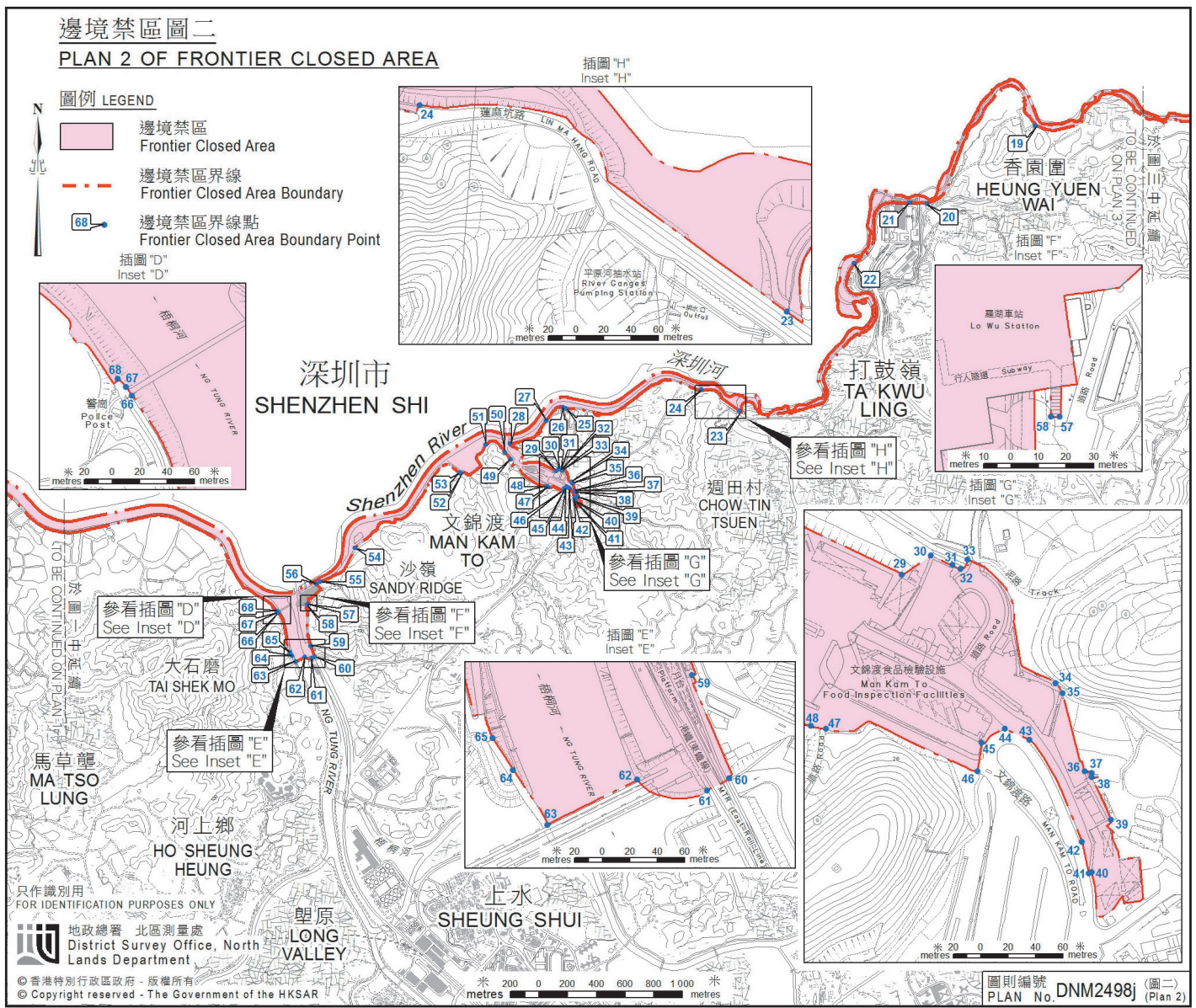

Explanatory Note

The boundary of the frontier closed area is specified in the Schedule to the Frontier Closed Area Order (Cap. 245 sub. leg. A).
