Explanatory Note

The Maritime Safety Committee of the International Maritime Organization passed resolution MSC.482(103) on 13 May 2021. The resolution adopts amendments to Chapter II-1 of the Annex to the International Convention for the Safety of Life at Sea, 1974. The amendments impose requirements relating to water level detectors for multiple hold cargo ships (other than bulk carriers or tankers) constructed on or after 1 January 2024.

2. This Regulation amends section 8 of the Merchant Shipping (Safety) (Construction and Survey) Regulation (Cap. 369 sub. leg. BD) to implement the requirements.
