# 資料說明 立法會環境事務委員會 2024年3月25日會議 《香港合資格環保專業人員學會條例草案》

#### 前言

1. 本文件之目的是向委員會提交擬議的《香港合資格環保專業人員學會條例草案》 ("**《條例草案》**")並徵求各位委員的意見。律政司法律草擬專員已發出證明書,證 明《條例草案》符合香港特別行政區立法會《議事規則》的條例草案格式及香港法例 的一般格式。《條例草案》及法律草擬專員的證明書載於本文件**附錄 A** 及 **B**。

#### 一般事項

2. 《條例草案》擬議採用議員私人條例草案的形式提交。《條例草案》將由盧偉 國議員推薦,並將按《基本法》第74條徵求行政長官同意把《條例草案》提交立法會。

#### 背景和目的

- 3. 《條例草案》的目的是給予香港合資格環保專業人員學會("「**環專會」**")法律認可組織的地位。透過立法,「環專會」將成為一個持續存在的獨特法律實體並只能透過立法會頒布的另一項法律作出解散。此舉旨在維護「環專會」的長期存在和獨立性。
- 4. 為了應對氣候變化帶來的種種挑戰,國家主席習近平在 2020 年 9 月表明中國會努力爭取在 2030 年前碳排放量達峰,並於 2060 年前實現碳中和,這「雙碳目標」是國家作出的重要承諾,也為未來建立綠色、低碳和循環經濟訂立了清晰的方向和策略。香港亦一直積極推動應對氣候變化的工作,特區政府在 2021 年 10 月公布《香港氣候行動藍圖 2050》,提出 2035 年前碳排放量減半,並致力爭取於 2050 年前實現碳中和。在此發展形勢之下,業界預期本港對環境專業人才的需求日益殷切。為了及時把握低碳轉型帶來的增長新動力,並把握與鄰近地區合作的機遇,香港需要完善環境

專業人士的專業資歷架構和持續專業發展,提升相關專業學會的地位,並培訓更多青年人成為具備相關知識和技能的專業人士,持續充實環境專業人才庫。

- 5. 「環專會」於 2015 年由一群來自環保業界、公共界別及現有環保專業機構的人士成立,不僅為應對這些挑戰,更藉此轉化為香港以及大灣區的發展機遇。「環專會」期望將香港轉化為卓越的專業環境服務中心,配合並支持環境服務業發展成為香港的支柱產業之一。這樣便可以提供清晰的專業路徑,為我們的未來和年輕一代創造更多優質就業機會,讓其追求綠色和可持續的事業,並進一步鞏固香港在專業行業的長期優勢。
- 6. 隨著人們對環境可持續性、氣候變化和碳中和的認識不斷增強,對環境專業人才的需求正不斷增長。提高這些專業人員的資格可以在再生能源、能源效益、可持續交通、可持續農業、廢物管理和環境顧問等各個領域創造新的就業機會。合資格環境專業人員還可以幫助確保環境可持續專案的融資,提供技術專業知識以評估專案的可行性並識別潛在的環境風險和機會。合資格環境專業人士可以進行環境盡職調查,以評估與投資相關的環境風險和機會,包括評估其環境影響、專案的監管合規性以及潛在的環境責任。審查環境、社會和企業管治(ESG)信息揭露及提供獨立的專業驗證,也可以確保投資符合 ESG 標準。這可以幫助識別任何潛在的漂綠或對環境影響的扭曲。憑藉高品質的評估和審查,這可以吸引對 ESG 相關投資感興趣的投資者。
- 7. 除了創造就業機會和吸引投資之外,具有可持續發展專業知識的環境專業人士可幫助公私營機構提高環境績效、減少碳足跡並實現 ESG 的相關目標。發展環境專業人員的資格可以激勵和吸引年輕人才加入該行業,這是因為他們未來在應對氣候變化和碳中和、保護自然資源和促進可持續發展方面的工作有重要性,並可發揮積極的影響力。
- 8. 「環專會」的成立是為了促進、發展和維護專注於六個環境領域專業評估的資格體系,即(1)環境科學、管理和政策,(2)空氣,(3)噪音,(4)環境影響評估和風險評估,(5)廢物和(6)水質,透過公開考試的方式滿足合格要求以及其他相關會員標準,以獲得參加專業面試的資格。在嚴格的專業評核要求下,2015年至2023年間,有超過 1 200 名考生參加了閉卷公開考試,而且「環專會」已成為一個本

地機構並擁有超過 660 名以香港為家的專業人士,正從事香港及大灣區的環保產業工作,其專業會員數量仍然不斷增加。

- 9. 「環專會」會員以其專業能力,參與香港各方面的環境保護工作。試舉以下數 例:(1)許多來自不同行業的公司,包括地產發展商、工程公司、顧問公司、公用事 業公司及法定機構,承諾支持環保專業人員的持續專業發展,並承諾於環境相關職位 認可由「環專會」鑒定合格的專業資格,並鼓勵相關人員追求「環專會」的專業資格; (2)「2022年青年高峰會」討論並展示了不同領域的青年環境專業人士,如何在大灣 區實現碳中和方面發揮積極作用; (3) 響應政府「綠色就業計劃」倡議而推出的 「環境畢業生啟導計劃(GEMS)」,促進環境畢業生的持續發展,並連繫畢業生和 環境行業專業人十,以提供分享經驗和知識的機會;(4)鼓勵教育機構提供在基本環 境原則方面具有適當廣度和特定領域深度,及加強學術和環境專業從業者之間合作的 環境學位課程「認證計劃」,已認證了香港科技大學、香港中文大學、香港浸會大學 和香港大學的不同大學本科課程;(5)推出了一項識別和認證環境電腦模擬從業人員 的認證計劃,以支持和鼓勵「環專會」會員在空氣和噪音電腦模擬方面的專業發展, 因其是香港環境影響評估和土地利用規劃過程的重要組成部分;以及(6)制定重點關 注環境和可持續發展觀點的環境、社會和企業管治(ESG)計劃,隨著香港綠色金融 發展,這將有助滿足對 ESG 績效的透明度和保證不斷提升的要求。
- 10. 除此之外,「環專會」亦積極參與不同持份者活動並發表環保專業意見,例如《長遠減碳策略》、《香港土地供應》、《推廣電動車》、證券及期貨事務監察委員會《有關基金經理管理及披露氣候相關風險的諮詢文件》、《2018 年廢物處置(都市固體廢物收費)(修訂)條例草案》、塑膠飲料容器生產者責任計劃公眾諮詢、政府公布《香港清新空氣藍圖 2035》以及行政長官施政報告等。
- 11. 合資格環境專業人員是信譽良好並受高度尊重的職業。他們在滿足當前和未來的環境專業知識需求、支持環境產業的發展以及維持香港合資格環境專業人士人才庫等方面都發揮重要作用。

#### 《條例草案》

- 12. 《條例草案》之目的是賦予「環專會」法團地位,使其成為永久繼承的法人實體,只有在立法會通過另一項法規後才能解散。這將確保「環專會」的長期存在和獨立性。
- 13. 擬議《條例草案》的主要條文,謹概述如下:
  - (a) 第1條列出條例簡稱。
  - (b) 第2條界定《條例草案》中所用的若干術語。
  - (c) 第3條訂明香港合資格環保專業人員學會成為法團。
  - (d) 第4條訂明香港合資格環保專業人員學會的宗旨。
  - (e) 第5條訂明香港合資格環保專業人員學會的權力。
  - (f) 第6條訂明香港合資格環保專業人員學會的財產歸屬事官。
  - (g) 第7條訂明香港合資格環保專業人員學會理事會的設立。
  - (h) 第8條訂明香港合資格環保專業人員學會理事會的權力。
  - (i) **第9條**處理會籍事官。
  - (i) 第10條訂明現行章程成為香港合資格環保專業人員學會章程。
  - (k) 第11條列出須呈交公司註冊處處長的資料。
  - (I) 第 12 條是香港特別行政區立法會議事規則第 50(8)條所要求載有的保留條文。

#### 諮詢

14. 環境及生態局及環境保護署長期以來一直支持「環專會」所推行的專業資格制度及對環境專業人士持續發展的推動,而政府當局的支持有助各界認識到專業資格的重要性,除了應對氣候變化和碳中和等全球挑戰,亦滿足環保領域對熟練專業人員日益增長的需求。環境保護署署長徐浩光博士的支持信函載於本文件**附錄 €**。

15. 為確保《條例草案》得到廣泛接受和有效實施,「環專會」亦諮詢受《條例草案》影響的不同範疇的其他持份者,均得到正面的回應及支持,並且在諮詢活動中進行了建設性交流。公眾持份者溝通活動於 2023 年 8 月 12 日上午和 2023 年 8 月 14 日辦公時間後安排,大多數持份者都支持「「環專會」成為法定組織。「環專會」也出席與不同持份者的個別會議/交流,介紹擬議《條例草案》對促進香港和大灣區環保專業和產業合作的益處。不同持份者,包括認可專業學會(香港工程師學會)、本地大學、環境相關機構、智庫和非政府組織,以及私人機構的支持信函載於本文件**附錄 D**。

#### 立法時間表

16. 在取得主席裁決以及行政長官批准後,我們爭取於 2024 年第二季將《條例草案》提交到本屆立法會。

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup>公眾持份者溝通活動收集到 60 份回覆,其中 95%(57 份回覆)表示支持成為法定組織團,收到的意見/建議包括(1)加強對環境專業人員在進行環境研究、設計和執行工作的操守監察,以及向公眾彰顯環境專業人員工作的正面形象,(2)「環專會」的會員資格獲取必須基於通過專業知識和道德選擇的相關考試,而不是基於隸屬關係,(3) 考慮法律化是環境從業者專業化的重要一步,(4) 透過認證促進環境職業的發展,(5) 促進年輕環境專業人員的職業發展,與及(6) 推廣環境產業的專業地位及提高國際認可。其中兩份回覆沒有對成為法團組織的擬議作出具體評論或提出擔憂。收到的一份反對意見提出的原因是「環專會」未能使用正確的途徑/評估方法考核環境產業內的真正專業人士。

# 本條例草案

# 旨在

對香港合資格環保專業人員學會成為法團及有關連的事宜作出規定。由立法會制定。

## 第1部

### 導言

1. 簡稱

本條例可引稱為《香港合資格環保專業人員學會條例》。

#### 2. 釋義

在本條例中 ----

名冊 (Register)指根據章程而設立的學會會員名冊;

年度 (year)指依照章程始於每年某日及終於每年某日的學會財政年度,但學會成為法團之日至翌年的 3 月 31 日期間,將被視為一財政年度;

秘書 (Secretary)指按照章程規定而委任的學會義務秘書;

理事會 (General Council)指根據第7條設立的學會理事會;

章程 (Constitution)指第 10 條所述現正生效的學會章程;

**會長** (President)指在第 7 條內稱為學會會長的人及根據章程規 定擔任會長職責的任何人;

會員 (member)指現時名列名冊的人;

## 香港合資格環保專業人員學會

#### 3. 香港合資格環保專業人員學會成為法團

- (1) 香港合資格環保專業人員學會現成為一個法團,稱為"香港合資格環保專業人員學會"。學會以該名義永久延續,並可起訴及被起訴,以及可在符合本條例的情況下進行與經受法團可以合法進行與經受的一切行動及事情。
- (2) 學會備有法團印章,須經理事會通過決議方可使用。法團 印章使用時,除章程另行規定外,理事會一名成員與秘書 或理事會委派代替秘書的另一人必須在場見證,各人須簽 署本身姓名。
- (3) 任何文件,如看來是用學會法團印章妥為簽立,並按第 (2)款簽署認證,則須獲接納為證據,而除非反證成立, 否則該文件須視作妥為簽立的文件。

#### 4. 學會的宗旨

#### 學會的宗旨如下 ——

- (a) 促進、發展和維持香港環保專業人員的資格制度;
- (b) 滿足香港當前和未來的環境專業知識需求;
- (c) 支持香港環保產業的發展;
- (d) 在香港備有合適資格的環保專業人員名冊;
- (e) 促進環保專業人員的持續專業發展,以滿足社會和 環境不斷變化的需求;
- (f) 通過會議或出版物,促進環保專業人員之間就當前 和新出現的環境相關挑戰和風險、技術、法規、政 策和利益相關者交流想法、知識和信息;
- (g) 促進不同專業和行業的環保知識進步,以改善香港 的環境;

- (h) 維護環保專業人員的誠信和地位,並在公眾和特區 政府面前作為代表;
- (i) 提供行業與本地政府機構和其他組織之間的聯繫, 以確保環保專業人員保持活力;及
- (j) 為實現上述宗旨,辦理理事會認為適當的一切其他 有關或有助的事宜。

#### 5. 學會的權力

在符合本條例的規定下,理事會可代表學會,辦理所有必需的、有連帶關係的或有助的事宜,以貫徹學會宗旨,而在不影響本條例條文的原則下,尤其可以 ——

- (a) 取得、承租、購買、持有和享用任何財產,以及將 財產出售、出租或以其他方式處置;
- (b) 訂立任何合約;
- (c) 為會員提供適當設施;
- (d) 僱用職員;
- (e) 為職員及造訪賓客提供住所;
- (f) 為職員提供退休金或分擔退休金的供款;
- (g) 擔任有關退休金計劃及獎學金和獎項基金的受託 人;
- (h) 以理事會認為適當或適宜的方式及抵押或條款借入 款項;
- (i) 以理事會認為適當或適宜的條件申請及接受任何津 貼以資助學會的活動;及
- (j) 以理事會認為適當或適宜的方式及規模將學會基金 投資。

#### 6. 財產的歸屬
