**Hon Jeffrey LAM's motion on  
“Actively responding to economic transformation and  
maintaining a favourable business environment”**

**Wording of the Motion**

That as Hong Kong is now at the stage of economic transformation, this Council urges the SAR Government to introduce feasible policy measures to support the development of local enterprises and maintain a favourable business environment in Hong Kong, including:

- (1) actively taking forward the task of attracting enterprises and investment, developing the headquarters economy and fostering the development of family offices in Hong Kong, with a view to bringing more new capital and diversified business into Hong Kong and creating a business environment that is favourable to the long-term development of Hong Kong;
- (2) further enhancing the talent policy to attract various types of talents, including international top talents, to Hong Kong for work and settlement, while adopting active measures to retain local talents, so as to provide local enterprises with suitable talents;
- (3) vigorously supporting the sustainable development of small and medium enterprises and assisting them in upgrading and transformation and opening up new business and markets, so that they can adapt to changes in the operation environment; and
- (4) further deepening and fostering cooperation among various bureaux and departments in the Government, and better improving the existing policies, measures and legislation relating to business operation, so as to foster the thriving development of local enterprises.
