Supplementary information on minor drainage improvement works in Sai Kung Panel on Development on 28 May 2024

During the meeting of the Panel on Development on 28 May 2024, the Administration was requested to provide supplementary information on minor drainage improvement works planned by the Drainage Services Department (DSD) to address potential flooding in other low-lying locations in Sai Kung during the construction of the proposed stormwater drains at Po Lo Che Road, Sai Kung. The Administration provides the supplementary information below:

The DSD has been implementing minor drainage improvement works in various districts throughout the territory to alleviate the flood risks. In relation to Sai Kung, the DSD is currently carrying out the construction of stormwater drains at Tai Mong Tsai Road near Pak Tam Chung Management Centre, targeting for completion in mid-2024. Furthermore, the DSD plans to construct flood walls along the existing drainage channel at Ho Chung Village near Che Kung Temple, and construct stormwater drains and flood walls along the existing drainage channel near Tai Chung Hau Road in Pak Kong. The DSD has invited tenders for the abovementioned works and the construction works are expected to commence in the third quarter of 2024 for target completion in stages in around one to two years.
