3069RG-2 — Amenity Complex in Area 103, Ma On Shan – main works

Follow-up Item:

At the request of the Panel, the Government shall provide information about the number and locations of the parking spaces which could serve as alternatives to the existing parking spaces in the temporary car park in Area 103, Ma On Shan, during the construction of the proposed works project.

Response:

According to recent surveys conducted by the Transport Department, the existing short-term tenancy car park in the project site accommodates about 120 vehicles and 200 vehicles at day-time and night-time respectively. The number of parking spaces near the project site available for public use is summarised below –
