**Capital Works Reserve Fund Head 710 Computerisation  
Subhead A007GX (Block Allocation) –  
New Administrative Computer Systems:  
2025-26 Estimates of Expenditure**

**Purpose**

This paper seeks Members' support for the 2025-26 Estimates under Capital Works Reserve Fund ("CWRF") Head 710 Computerisation Subhead **A007GX** (Block Allocation) – New Administrative Computer Systems.

**Computerisation Block Allocation**

2. Each year, the Digital Policy Office ("DPO") assesses the funding requirements for Subhead **A007GX** in the following financial year having regard to factors such as cash flow requirements of approved block vote projects, new project proposals submitted by bureaux/departments ("B/Ds"), new projects relating to digital government service initiatives, and spending position of the Block Allocation.

3. In proposing new computerisation projects, B/Ds are required to adopt the following guiding principles -

- (a) to manage and use information and communications technology to support the implementation of digital government services as a major mode of service provision;
- (b) to integrate digital government services into the overall business plans of B/Ds and introduce service transformation and business process re-engineering in all organisational / business reviews to enhance business benefits and drive digital transformation;

- (c) to embrace a people-centric culture in the delivery of public services and encourage the public to adopt the most efficient, user-friendly and cost-effective channels;
- (d) to proactively identify opportunities for implementation of cross-departmental services and data sharing, take ownership of these services and account for their performance / benefits; and
- (e) to support the development of Hong Kong into a world-class smart city.

4. Moreover, the DPO requires B/Ds to regularly review their project timetable in light of the latest progress of the approved projects, so as to derive realistic cash flow requirements and set aside the required allocation for the next financial year.

#### **2025-26 Estimates of Expenditure**

5. A Block Allocation of **\$2,520 million** will be required under Subhead **A007GX** for 2025-26, which is \$390 million (or 18.3%) higher than the provision of \$2,130 million in 2024-25. A breakdown of the expenditure items for 2024-25 and 2025-26 is at **Annex A**. The proposed estimates will enable the Government, through information technology (“IT”) projects, to accelerate the digital transformation of government services, launch more digital services that can benefit the public and the business sector, improve the standards of public services and operational efficiency, as well as strengthen system security to support the development of digital government and digital economy.

6. The estimates of expenditure for 2025-26 mentioned above will be used for meeting the estimated cash flow requirements of a total of 1,125 new, ongoing and soon to be implemented projects, with around 70% of these projects (794 projects) implemented / to be implemented in or before 2024-25 involving cash flow requirements of \$2,067 million in 2025-26 (or 82.0% of the estimates of expenditure for the next financial year). A majority of the ongoing projects are expected to be completed or will be in the advanced stages of project implementation in 2025-26, and hence the cash flow requirements which tend to fall in these stages are expected to

increase. The remaining 30% of these projects (331 projects) are new projects proposed to be implemented in 2025-26. The details are at **Annex B** and **Annex C** respectively.

7. The new projects proposed under the 2025-26 Block Allocation can be broadly classified into the following four major categories –

(a) Digital government services

In 2020, we launched the one-stop personalised digital services platform “iAM Smart”, and have been upgrading its services and functions in phases since 2024 for better service integration, enhancing user experience and development of more services that are convenient and beneficial to the public and businesses. We aim to facilitate the full adoption of “iAM Smart” in all government online services by the end of 2025 so as to realise the goal of “single portal for online government services”. To bring convenience to members of the public and promote data sharing among B/Ds, we have also developed the Consented Data Exchange Gateway (“CDEG”) for B/Ds’ use, and plan to enable citizens to authorise sharing of their personal data among systems of government departments via CDEG by the end of 2024, thus alleviating the need to repeatedly submit their personal information when applying for government services and improving the user experience in using digital government services. Against this background, the proposed new digital government services projects in 2025-26 include –

- (i) implementation of digital signing for medical documents issued by the Department of Health (e.g. sick leave certificates, attendance certificates, referral letters, prescriptions, etc.) and enabling sharing of digitally signed medical documents with “eHealth” and other mobile applications (Department of Health);
- (ii) enhancement of Central Registry for Rehabilitation Information Management System for adoption of “e-Proof”, new features of “iAM Smart” and CDEG to issue Registration Card for People with Disabilities (Labour and Welfare

Bureau); and

- (iii) enhancement of existing system for full adoption of electronic tendering for non-works tenders, enabling tenderers to obtain the latest tender information, submit tenders and handle documents via a single user account, etc. (Financial Services and the Treasury Bureau).

(b) Enhancing operational efficiency of the Government

Apart from the provision of public services, B/Ds will also make use of various IT systems to enhance internal operational efficiency and productivity, and cope with business growth. Leveraging innovative technologies such as artificial intelligence (“AI”), big data analytics and blockchain can enhance operational efficiency of the Government and improve city management, which will enable provision of better public services. To drive adoption of innovative technologies by B/Ds, the DPO launched the new generation Government Cloud Infrastructure Service (“GCIS”), Big Data Analytics Platform, Shared Blockchain Platform and “e-Proof” as the common service and reference module for B/Ds’ use, so as to enhance efficiency of developing and operating digital government services. The proposed new projects in this category in 2025-26 include –

- (i) development of a system using blockchain technology to implement smart contracts, enabling contract management and sharing of works information on a single platform and facilitating digital works (Civil Engineering and Development Department);
- (ii) development of Animal Welfare Case Information System, an online platform to be hosted on GCIS, for sharing information of cases of cruelty to animals, providing an information interface for searching of cases, interfacing with existing information systems and adopting “iAM Smart” for logging in to the platform (Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department); and

- (iii) enhancement of CDEG through adopting AI technology to align the formats of address data kept by individual B/Ds to facilitate exchange of address data within the Government via CDEG, etc. (DPO).

(c) System technology refresh

System technology refresh is an on-going task of B/Ds to ensure that the systems can support related public services and digital government services in a secure and effective manner. Apart from addressing the problems of ageing system hardware and obsolete software, system efficiency and functionality could be enhanced by leveraging next generation technology. Moreover, the Government will continue to adopt cloud computing to enhance agility, security and efficiency in meeting the growing demand of B/Ds on IT resources. The proposed new projects falling under this category include –

- (i) technology refresh of server infrastructure for Computerised Social Security System II (Social Welfare Department);
- (ii) revamp of Enforcement Management Information System of the Office of the Licensing Authority and its migration to GCIS (Home Affairs Department); and
- (iii) enhancement of Government News and Media Information System to upgrade software components and provide new functions such as user-defined filters to display press releases of specific B/Ds or keywords, etc. (Information Services Department).

(d) IT security

Amidst the ever-increasing number and complexity of cyber security threats, DPO will step up supervision on B/Ds' work on strengthening the security of their IT systems. B/Ds will conduct security risk assessments and audits on IT systems regularly and continuously in accordance with the latest IT security policies, and implement measures to strengthen the defence capabilities of

government IT systems against various security threats and cyber attacks. Examples of new projects under this category include –

- (i) setting up of Centralised Security Information and Event Management System and replacement of hardware for departmental security devices (Lands Department);
- (ii) enhancement of departmental IT security and network infrastructure (Labour Department); and
- (iii) conducting IT Security Risk Assessment and Audit, etc. (Rating and Valuation Department).

### **Submission of Funding Proposal to FC**

8. Subject to support of the proposal by the Panel, the Government will submit the 2025-26 estimates of expenditure of all block allocations under CWRP (including Subhead **A007GX**) to the Public Works Subcommittee (“PWSC”) and seek funding approval from the Finance Committee (“FC”).

### **Advice Sought**

9. Members are invited to support the submission of 2025-26 estimates of expenditure for CWRP Head 710 Subhead **A007GX** (Block Allocation) to the PWSC.

### **Background**

10. FC has approved the establishment of block allocation subheads under different Heads of Expenditure of CWRP. At present, there are a total of 26 CWRP block allocation subheads, covering different types of expenditure on public works, land acquisition, capital subvention and computerisation projects.

11. Head 710 Computerisation Subhead **A007GX** (Block Allocation) –

New Administrative Computer Systems is used for funding the administrative computer systems and consultancies for feasibility studies and systems development of B/Ds. The cost of each project under this Subhead is between \$200,001 and the financial ceiling of \$20 million<sup>1</sup>.

12. Under the block allocation arrangement, FC approves the delegation of power to the Financial Secretary (“FS”) and the FS then has delegated to the Commissioner for Digital Policy the power to approve projects and authorise expenditure under the Block Allocation. Projects with expenditure exceeding the above ceiling should be submitted to FC for funding approval individually. This block allocation arrangement can expedite the approval of more small-scale IT projects, thereby increasing the efficiency of implementing Government’s IT projects and supporting B/Ds to continuously upgrade their systems and improve their operations, and allow the FC to focus on processing the funding application of large-scale IT projects.
