### Follow up Action:

The Administration was requested to provide the following supplementary information on the utilization rates of the Automated Parking System on weekdays, weekends, and public holidays:

### Administration's response:

The Automated Parking Systems (APS) at the short-term tenancy (STT) car parks at Hoi Shing Road, Tsuen Wan; Fo Shing Road, Pak Shek Kok, Tai Po; and Tung Chau Street, Sham Shui Po were commissioned in November 2021, December 2022, and April 2024, respectively. These systems were financed and constructed by the STT tenants concerned, and were operated on a commercial basis.

According to information provided by the tenants, the APS parking spaces in Tsuen Wan and Tai Po are let out on a monthly basis, while the APS parking spaces in Sham Shui Po are let on both a monthly and hourly basis. According to the observations of the Transport Department, utilization rates of APS generally vary over time after commissioning. The rates may be relatively low at the initial operational stage, but will rise steadily and stabilize over time as drivers become more familiar with the operation of the system.

The average day-time utilization rates of the APS at the above three STT car parks on weekdays (Monday to Friday) in the third quarter of 2024 ranged from approximately 60% to 90%, while the night-time utilization rates ranged from approximately 70% to 90%. On weekends and public holidays, the average day-time and night-time utilization rates varied from approximately 70% to 90%.
