

A BILL

To

Approve a supplementary appropriation to the services of the Government in the financial year that ended on 31 March 2025.

Enacted by the Legislative Council.

1. Short title

This Ordinance may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (2024–2025) Ordinance.

2. Approval of appropriation

The appropriation in the manner expressed in the Schedule of a sum of \$10,195,754,164.80 from the general revenue for the services of the Government in the financial year that ended on 31 March 2025 is approved.
