Council meeting of 23 July 2025

**Amendments to Hon CHAN Pui-leung's motion on
"Addressing the retirement needs of the middle class
and building a high-quality health and wellness ecosystem"**

The President has given permission for three Members (Hon Robert LEE, Hon Stanley LI and Dr Hon TAN Yueheng) to move amendments to Hon CHAN Pui-leung's motion. The terms of the original motion and the marked-up version of the amendments (LC Paper No. CB(1)1199/2025(01)) are **attached** for Members' information.

2. The President will order a joint debate on the above motion and the amendments. I set out below the relevant proceedings in which the President will:

- (a) call upon the motion mover to speak and move the motion;
- (b) propose the question on the motion;
- (c) call upon the Members who wish to move amendments to the motion to speak in the following order, but no amendment is to be moved at this stage:
 - (i) Hon Robert LEE;
 - (ii) Hon Stanley LI; and
 - (iii) Dr Hon TAN Yueheng;
- (d) call upon the public officer(s) to speak;

- (e) invite other Members to speak;
- (f) call upon the motion mover to speak on the amendments;
- (g) call upon the public officer(s) to speak again;
- (h) deal with the amendments in the order set out in paragraph (c) above, i.e. first invite the mover of the first amendment to move the amendment and forthwith propose and put to vote the question on the amendment, and thereafter proceed to deal with the remaining amendment(s); and
- (i) after all amendments have been dealt with, call upon the motion mover to reply, and then put to vote the question on the motion, or the motion as amended, as the case may be.

3. Members are reminded that in accordance with Appendix IIIA to the House Rules, the **maximum duration of this joint debate (including voting) is four hours**. The motion mover will have a total of 10 minutes to make introductory speech and reply (paragraph 2(a) and (i) above refers), and another five minutes to speak on the amendment(s) (paragraph 2(f) above refers). The mover(s) of the amendment(s) and other Members may each speak once up to a maximum of five minutes.

Motion debate on
“Addressing the retirement needs of the middle class
and building a high-quality health and wellness ecosystem”

1. Hon CHAN Pui-leung’s original motion

That this Council urges the Government to attach importance to and address the retirement needs of the middle class, and actively explore and build a high-quality local-cum-cross-boundary health and wellness ecosystem that is government-led, market-operated, socially-collaborated, etc. with participation of multiple entities.

2. Motion as amended by Hon Robert LEE

That *Premier of the State Council LI Qiang proposed in the Report on the Work of the Government delivered during the ‘two sessions’ of the country in 2025 to deepen the reform of elderly care services*; this Council urges the Government to attach importance to and address the retirement needs of the middle class, and actively explore and build a high-quality local-cum-cross-boundary health and wellness ecosystem that is government-led, market-operated, socially-collaborated, etc. with participation of multiple entities, *as well as further promote pension finance, so that finance can empower the development of the elderly care industry to cater for different retirement needs of the middle class.*

3. Motion as amended by Hon Stanley LI

That *some elderly persons with higher spending power are not only concerned about basic retirement needs, but also tend to focus more on ‘quality retirement’; in this connection*, this Council urges the Government to attach importance to and address the retirement needs of the middle class, and *establish standards on products and services catered for the elderly covering service operation and management as well as product quality control, and also promote such standards in the Greater Bay Area and overseas markets, so as to ensure the quality of products and services catered for the elderly; at the same time, the Government should also* actively explore and build a high-quality local-cum-cross-boundary health and wellness ecosystem that is government-led, market-operated, socially-collaborated, etc. with participation of multiple entities.

4. Motion as amended by Dr Hon TAN Yueheng

That this Council urges the Government to attach importance to and address the retirement needs of the middle class, and actively explore and build a high-quality local-cum-cross-boundary health and wellness ecosystem that is government-led, market-operated, socially-collaborated, etc. with participation of multiple entities; *and this Council also urges the Government to support and encourage financial institutions to develop innovative retirement financial tools, so as to provide diversified financial protection for the retirement of the middle class.*
