Amendments to be moved by the Honourable LEE Chun-keung

<u>Clause</u>	<u>Amendment Proposed</u>
Long title	By deleting “to prohibit the sale of conventional smoking products that contain specified additives, or are held out as containing flavourings, and the sale of products that are designed for, or held out by sellers to be capable of imparting flavourings to, conventional smoking products; to implement a certification regime for conventional smoking products;”.
1(3)(e)	By deleting “10” and substituting “9”.
2	By deleting “10” and substituting “9”.
35	By adding before subclause (1) — “(1AA) Section 18(1) — <b>Repeal</b> “Chief Executive in Council” <b>Substitute</b> “Secretary”.”.
35	By adding before subclause (3) — “(2A) After section 18(1) — <b>Add</b> “(1A) A regulation made under subsection (1) — (a) may prescribe offences for contravention of a regulation, punishable by a fine, imprisonment or both; and (b) may provide for defences to such offences. (1B) The maximum penalty that may be prescribed by a regulation made under subsection (1) for an offence is a fine at level 5 and imprisonment for 6 months.”.”.
