Subcommittee on Promoting the Development of Hong Kong into an International Education Hub under the Panel on Education of the Legislative Council

Follow-up Items from the Meeting on 18 February 2025

At the Subcommittee meeting on 18 February 2025, Members requested the Government to provide the number and percentage of non-local students who have enrolled in the eight universities funded by the University Grants Committee ("UGC") in the 2024/25 academic year (AY). The Professor Honourable CHOW Man-kong also requested the Education University of Hong Kong ("EdUHK") to provide supplementary information on the number of non-local students as mentioned at the meeting. Relevant information is set out below for reference.

In the 2024/25 AY, the number of non-local students enrolling in UGC-funded programmes is 26 600. Among them, some 17 200 students are enrolled in undergraduate programmes, which is equivalent to about 23.2% of local student places. The Government is pleased to see that the UGC-funded universities have successfully made use of the relaxed enrolment ceiling to recruit more non-local students to pursue their studies in Hong Kong. The actual

enrollment of non-local students in UGC-funded universities, as well as the corresponding percentages relative to local student places in the 2024/25 AY are set out at **Annex A**.

As regards the number of non-local students mentioned by the EdUHK at the meeting, EdUHK indicated that the relevant percentage refers to the increase in <u>intake figures</u> of non-local students in full-time UGC-funded undergraduate programmes in the 2024/25 AY over the 2023/24 AY (i.e. an increase of 123 students to 261 students). The response from EdUHK is at <u>Annex B</u>.

UGC-funded Research Postgraduate (RPg) Programmes

In the 2024/25 academic year, there are 7 200 student places for UGC-funded RPg programmes. Universities may admit both local and non-local students for the RPg student places allocated to them, and over-enrol by up to 100% of their allocated student places. The non-local student enrolment ceiling (and the equivalent percentage points) are not applicable to RPg programmes.

Reply from the Education University of Hong Kong

In the 2024/25 academic year, the Education University of Hong Kong (EdUHK) admitted a total of 261 non-local students (as of programme commencement, i.e. 2 September 2024) to government-funded full-time undergraduate programmes, of whom 237 were admitted to the first year of the undergraduate programmes, accounting for 40% outside the local student quota (i.e., 593) for that year. The number of non-local students admitted has more than doubled compared with the 107 non-local students admitted to first-year undergraduate programmes in the 2023/24 academic year. Please see Table 1 for details.

The admissions status of full-time government-funded undergraduate programmes for the 2024/25 academic year was compared with that of the 2023/24 academic year, which effectively reflects the differences between this year and the previous year.

As of 31 October 2024, the total number of full-time equivalent (FTE) students, the number and proportion of non-local students enrolled in EdUHK's government-funded programmes in the 2024/25 academic year are detailed in Table 2. The EdUHK mainly admit non-local students to the first-year first-degree undergraduate programmes and the full-time Postgraduate Diploma in Education programmes. Though the EdUHK programmes have distinctive features among other government-funded universities, the University will continue to leverage the efforts and experience of various departments and units in admissions of non-local students in the 2024/25 academic year in response to the government's policy of increasing the number of places for non-local students in government-funded universities. EdUHK will continue to explore opportunities for increasing both the proportion and the number of non-local students in order to enhance the international learning environment and cultural exchanges at the University, in line with the government's goal of consolidating Hong Kong's position as an international education hub.

Since early 2024, EdUHK has been gradually expanding the enrollment of non-local students. While increasing the number of non-local students, institutions are obliged to ensure that sufficient supporting facilities and learning arrangements are in place. EdUHK has also carefully reviewed relevant supporting facilities and measures, such as accommodation, internship requirements for concerned programmes, student services, etc., to help mainland and overseas students integrate into local student life and learning for all-round development, thereby achieving an inclusive multicultural campus.
