Creation of two directorate posts and increase in NAMS ceiling of Information Technology and Broadcasting Bureau

## **INTRODUCTION**

At the meeting held on 9 June 1999, the Establishment Subcommittee endorsed the proposal to create two supernumerary directorate posts of one Administrative Officer Staff Grade B (D3) and one Chief Engineer (D1) for a period of three years; and increase the ceiling placed on the total notional annual mid-point salary value of all non-directorate posts in the establishment of Information Technology and Broadcasting Bureau (ITBB) in 1999-2000 from \$25,746,000 by \$3,166,560 to \$28,912,560 for the creation of five non-directorate posts.
