政府可否告知本會:

- (a) 在審批持有"回美紙"及中國護照的人士所提出的入境簽證申請方面,入境事務處採取的政策及準則爲何;
- (b) 入境事務處爲何於上月拒絕 11 名持有"回美紙"及中國護照並 計劃來港出席國際研討會的人士所提出的入境簽證申請;該處 在作出有關決定時,有否考慮拒絕讓該等人士來港對香港的國 際形象會否產生負面影響;及
- (b) 香港在回歸前的入境政策與回歸後的入境政策是否一致;若 然,該 11 名人士當中曾於香港回歸前獲准入境的人士,爲何現 在被入境事務處拒絕發出入境簽證;若否,詳情爲何?

#### (1) Hon LEE Wing-tat (Oral Reply)

Will the Government inform this Council:

- (a) of the policies and criteria adopted by the Immigration Department ("ID") for processing entry visa applications from the holders of "US re-entry permits" and Chinese passports;
- (b) of the reasons for the ID's rejection last month of the entry visa applications by 11 holders of "US re-entry permits" and Chinese passports, who had planned to attend an international seminar in Hong Kong; and whether, in making such a decision, the ID has considered if the refusal of these persons' entry into Hong Kong would produce any negative effects on the image of Hong Kong internationally; and
- (c) whether the entry policies of Hong Kong before and after the reunification with China are consistent; if so, why some of the 11 persons in question who had been allowed entry into Hong Kong before the reunification are now denied entry visas by the ID; if not, the details of that?
