Please be advised that we are at the stage of analysing in detail the legal status of the Chief Executive (CE) in the context of the Prevention of Bribery Ordinance (Cap. 201) and the Basic Law in consultation with the Department of Justice. This is a fundamental question which needs to be addressed prior to studying the applicability of the Ordinance to the CE.
