Assessment of new jobs created/ to be created in the period May 1998 - December 2000 as a result of Government's major policy initiatives and key projects

1. <u>Introduction</u>

Following our first attempt in June 1998 to assess the number of new jobs which will be generated by the Government's major policy initiatives, spending items and infrastructural and public works projects, we have carried out a further assessment, towards the end of December last year, to gauge actual results. We have also tried to assess the number of new jobs which will be generated during the two years from 1999 to 2000.

2. Overall results : A Synopsis

Estimates in June 1998

- 2.1 We estimated back in June 1998 that at least 100,000 job vacancies will come onto the labour market over the period from 1 May 1998 to 31 December 1999 as a result of the Government's major policy initiatives and key projects and the need of the civil service (Annex I refers).
- 2.2 Out of this total estimate, civil service job vacancies to be filled up in the financial year of 1998-99 accounted for 11,000 jobs to be created, while around 89,000 new jobs were expected to be created either in the private sector or in the non-Governmental Organisations receiving Government subvention (Annex I refers).
- 2.3 Out of this estimated 89,000 non-Government jobs, **32,674** were expected to be created by December 1998 (Annex II refers).

Jobs Created between May and December 1998

2.4 According to our latest assessment, for the civil service, **9,400** job vacancies will be filled in the financial year of 1998-99 (Annex I refers). This estimated number of civil service vacancies to be filled has been revised downward by 1,600 mainly because the

actual retirement figure has been lower than we estimated. Up to the end of December 1998, 5,600 vacancies were filled. These are permanent posts at all levels and spread over a wide spectrum of bureaux/departments.

- Outside the civil service, **32,763** new jobs have been created between May and December 1998 as a result of the Government's key policy initiatives and major projects (Annex II refers). This is almost identical with our previous forecast of 32,674. In most areas, the actual numbers of jobs created more or less met the forecasts, except for public works building projects where 2,200 less jobs were created which were mainly due to the deferral of a number of government departmental quarter projects. On the other hand, the actual numbers of jobs created in the areas of hospital services and housing were higher than expected, by 1,331 and 610 respectively, mainly due to advancement in the provision of additional hospital facilities and an increase in building construction activities.
- 2.6 Out of the 32,763 new jobs created, 12,064 are permanent, while 20,699 are project based ones with an average duration of 28 months (Annex II refers). 9,705 of these jobs fall within the category of professional, managerial, administrative or supervisory levels while 23,058 are operative/clerical and supporting levels.

New Jobs to be Created between January 1999 to December 2000

- 2.7 As a result of the Government's key policy initiatives and major infrastructural or other projects and the requirements of the civil service, we expect that some **122,000** job vacancies will be generated within the labour market over the next two years (Annex III refers). A summary analysis of this figure is as follows:
- (a) About **32,000** will be permanent jobs, and **90,000** project based ones with an average duration of 25 months depending on the length of individual projects or programmes (Annex III refers);

- (b) **113,500** will come from the private sector and non-Government organisations receiving Government subventions, and **8,500** from the civil service; the civil service vacancies will be filled during the 1999-2000 financial year (Annex III refers);
- (c) **20,000** will fall within the category of professional, managerial, administrative or supervisory levels while **102,000** operative/clerical and supporting levels (Annexes IV and V refer);
- (d) Of the 113,500 non-Government new jobs, some 66,000 will be created in 1999, which has been revised upward by 9,000 from the June forecast of 57,000; and **47,500** will be created in 2000 (Annex III refers).

3. Reasons underlying the creation of new jobs

3.1 The vast majority of these new jobs flow directly or indirectly from the various policy commitments, initiatives or key projects which seek to either provide new services or improve existing ones in a wide spectrum of public services or facilities. The new jobs to be created represent either the estimated manpower requirements of implementing key projects (such as the number and type of workers required to construct a railway), or the job opportunities arising from these initiatives (such as the liberalisation of the telecommunications market and investment promotion).

4. <u>Major areas of creation (Non-government new jobs)</u>

4.1 The majority of new jobs to be created during the next two years arise from initiatives, developments, or projects in the following areas:

Infrastructural Development Projects

4.2 The Government is spending about \$235 billion on infrastructural projects in the five years up to 2002-03, which is 50% above the Airport Core Projects. These projects will altogether generate **53,482** job opportunities in 1999 and 2000, comprising 6,944 at the professional or managerial levels and 46,538 at the operative/supporting levels. Such projects can be broadly divided into the following 8 categories:

- (a) 21,776 from railway projects, including
 - i) construction of KCRC West Rail (Phase 1), MTR Tseung Kwan O Extension and MTR Quarry Bay Congestion Relief Works; and
 - ii) KCR extension projects including Ma On Shan to Tai Wai Rail Link, KCR Extension from Hung Hom to Tsim Sha Tsui and Lok Ma Chau Spur Line.
- (b) 7,600 from roads and highways projects, including widening of Tolo Highway between Island House Interchange and Ma Liu Shui Interchange and Tsing Yi North Coastal Road; design consultancies of Route 9, Route 10, Route 16, Central Kowloon Route; Improvement to Kam Tin Road; Lantau North-South road link between Tai Ho Wan and Mui Wo; construction of Road T5 and Route 16 (Tai Wai Section);
- (c) 7,400 from sewerage and drainage projects including West Kowloon Drainage Improvement works, Wanchai East and North Point Sewerage Stage 2 works, Aberdeen, Ap Lei Chau and Pok Fu Lam Sewerage, and Outlying Islands Sewerage Stage I Phase I;
- (d) **4,400** from port works including Tseung Kwan O Port Development at area 137 remaining works, design consultancy of Tsuen Wan Bay further reclamation development and Tsuen Wan Bay further reclamation, Penny's Bay Reclamation, design consultancies of Green Island Development;
- (e) 3,000 from projects related to the Chek Lap Kok Airport, including the construction of the Second Runway and other construction works of the Airport;
- (f) **1,800 from site formation** works including South East Kowloon development and site formation of Tai Po Area 12 (part) and 39 Phase 2; Tin Shui Wai further development, formation in Sha Tin areas; and

- (g) 1,300 from waterworks including water supply to West Kowloon and to South East Kowloon Development; Mainlaying between Yuen Long and Tan Kwai Tsuen, Mainlaying in Mongkok, Ho Man Tin and Sham Shui Po and water supply to new development areas in Yuen Long; and
- (h) 4,100 from slope works, waste management and other miscellaneous projects.
- 4.3 Apart from the above public-funded projects, the following two port development projects will also generate substantial job opportunities during these two years:
- (a) The construction work of the *River Trade Terminal project in Tuen Mun Area* 38 will give rise to 1,206 new job opportunities; and
- (b) The construction of Container Terminal No. 9 (CT9) will give rise to 900 job opportunities.

Public Works Building Projects

Apart from infrastructural development projects, the Government will also spend over \$65 billion on *public works building projects* in the next five years. These projects will produce 20,400 new jobs for the private sector during 1999 and 2000, comprising 3,210 at the professional/managerial levels such as engineers and surveyors, and 17,190 at the operative levels, mainly on-site construction workers. Major projects which will generate employment opportunities in 1999 and 2000 include *Public Health Laboratory Centre, departmental quarters* at West Kowloon, Lai King and Kwun Tong, *redevelopment of police headquarters* at Arsenal Yard, *expansion of kiosks and other facilities at Lok Ma Chau Boundary, new penal institutions* at Yam O and High Island, and improvement works to existing schools.

Housing

- 4.5 The Government will be implementing a massive housing programme aimed at providing 50,000 public housing units a year over the next 10 years, up 35% from the yearly average of 37,000 (excluding sandwich class housing) in the past several years. The construction works, together with the related infrastructural and management works, will give rise to some *9,017* job opportunities in the next two years in the private sector. These comprise 1,016 professional or managerial or supervisory posts, and 8,001 at the operative levels (mainly construction workers). A broad breakdown of these jobs by major areas of activities is as follows:
- (a) 5,307 jobs (2,499 permanent jobs and 2,808 project based jobs) for the *public housing construction/civil engineering programme*;
- (b) **2,900** permanent jobs for the *management of newly completed commercial premises and home ownership flats* etc., through private management agencies, involving jobs such as property management professionals, property maintenance technicians, cleansing operators, clerks and security guards; and
- (c) 810 permanent jobs in the private sector for tower guards for the upgrading of security system in existing public rental estates.

Tourism

4.6 Together, there will be some 5,384 new jobs created in tourism industry in 1999 and 2000. The granting of the former Tamar Site to the Hong Kong Tourist Association for facilitating the staging of recreational, entertainment and tourismoriented activities will generate some 2,600 new jobs including 6 permanent jobs and 2,594 project based ones in 1999 and 2000. Besides, the Government fund of \$100 million to establish an "International Events Fund" will generate an estimated 2,784 new jobs including 70 permanent jobs and 2,714 project based jobs in the private sector in 1999 and 2000. The major jobs to be created include production managers, producers, print and production technicians, stage managers, public relations executives, ushers, performers, music directors, sales staff, transport operators and cleansing staff.

Social Welfare

4.7 The Social Welfare Department and the various subvented Non-Government Organisations will be providing employment opportunities, in 1999 and 2000, through a wide spectrum of welfare programmes in elderly services, family and child care, rehabilitation, youth services and administration of the social security system. These include, in particular, the provision of residential care homes for the elderly, child care centres, as well as day and residential services for people with disabilities. These will create around 2,993 additional jobs, comprising 584 at the professional/managerial levels (including mainly Social Welfare Officers, Social Welfare Assistants, nurses and allied health personnel) and 2,409 at the clerical/supportive levels (including mainly clerical grade staff).

Telecommunications

- During 1999 and 2000, it is estimated that some **2,966** new jobs will be created in the private sector. They include 459 at the professional/managerial levels and 2,507 at the operative/supportive levels. The estimated breakdown of the majority of these jobs by major activities is as follows:
- (a) 796 as a result of further liberalisation of external and local fixed telecommunication network services markets;
- (b) 675 from liberalisation of external telecommunication services market;
- (c) 822 from local mobile services operators;
- (d) 500 from Video-on-demand and interactive multi-media services; and
- (e) 160 for fixing the Year 2000 problem in telecommunications equipment such as private telephone exchanges, interactive voice response systems etc.

Building Management

4.9 Some **2,940** new jobs will be created as a result of building

management projects. Of these, about 653 are at the professional/managerial levels, and 2,287 are at the operative/clerical levels. Major projects and their respective new jobs generated are as follows:

- (a) **2,000** for meeting requirements arising from the introduction of mandatory **building management** initiatives;
- (b) 818 for stepping up enforcement action on unsafe old buildings and encouraging owners to join the Building Safety Inspection Scheme; and
- (a) 106 for accelerating the clearance of unauthorised rooftop structures to improve fire safety of buildings involving clearance of some 1,000 rooftop structures per year.

Industrial Promotion and Development

- 4.10 Some **2,490** new jobs will be created in the private sector as a result of on-going support services and a few large-scale capital projects which aimed at facilitating the long-term development of high value-added and high-tech industries in Hong Kong. Of these, about 516 are at the professional/managerial levels, and 1,974 are at the operative/clerical levels. A broad breakdown of the majority of these jobs by major projects is as follows:
- (a) 1450 from the development of the Second Industrial Technology Centre;
- (b) 461 from committed investment projects arising from investment promotion activities;
- (c) 245 arising from projects funded by the Industrial Support Fund which provides financial support for projects which can contribute to Hong Kong's industrial or technological developments and are conducive to enhancing the competitiveness of Hong Kong's manufacturing industry; and
- (d) 156 from the development of the Hong Kong Science Park Phase One at Pak Shek Kok, Tai Po.

Education

- 4.11 An estimated **2,147** new jobs are expected to be created during 1999 and 2000. Of this, about 1,617 are at the professional or managerial levels while some 530 are at the operative/supportive levels. These new jobs arise mainly from the following major initiatives:
- (a) 561 additional staff including 500 teaching/administrative staff and 61 non-teaching clerical staff to fill new positions arising from operation of new and converted whole-day primary schools;
- (b) 372 additional teaching and supporting staff arising from the opening of new schools and provision of additional clerical support to secondary schools;
- (c) 285 additional teachers for primary schools to support library service and the Chinese and English Extensive Reading Schemes;
- (d) 205 additional teaching staff to be provided to schools due to more use of Chinese as the medium of instruction;
- (e) 615 additional staff including 256 teachers/administrative staff and 359 supporting staff for wider use of information technology in schools;
- (f) 46 additional teaching posts for improvement of Student Guidance Teacher to pupil ratio in primary schools; and
- (g) 50 additional staff including 30 teaching staff and 20 supporting staff for the pilot project on integration of children with special needs in ordinary schools.

Environmental Protection

- 4.12 Some **1,895** new jobs will be created in 1999 and 2000 as a result of environmental protection projects. Of these, about 122 are at the professional/managerial levels, and 1,773 are at the operative/clerical levels. Major projects and their respective new jobs generated are as follows:
- (a) 950 from the implementation of the 10-year Waste Reduction Framework Plan;

- (b) 645 for phasing out diesel taxis and replacing them with LPG taxis;
- (c) 100 from Northwest New Territories Refuse Transfer Station;
- (d) 59 from the project of Northwest New Territories Landfills and Gin Drinkers Bay Landfill Restoration;
- (e) 40 from clinical waste disposal at the Chemical Waste Treatment Facility;
- (f) 31 from operating denitrification facility at the Northeast New Territories landfill operation;
- (g) 26 from the provision of a purpose-built facility for packaging and storing low-level radioactive waste; and
- (h) 24 from the capital project of Outlying Islands Transfer Facilities.

Hospital services

4.13 The Hospital Authority plans to create some **1,878** new jobs in 1999 and 2000 for the services arising from *new bed openings* in North District Hospitals, Tai Po Hospital, Pamela Youde Nethersole Hospital, United Christian Hospital, Yan Chai Hospital, Kowloon Medical Rehabilitation centre, Tseung Kwan O Hospital and Hong Kong Eye Hospital. These 1,878 new jobs comprise 1,544 new job vacancies for professional/administrative/supervisory staff including doctors, nurses, allied health professionals (physiotherapists, occupational therapists, radiographers, pharmacists, dispensers and medical social workers), and 334 other supporting staff (including clerks, workmen, healthcare assistants).

Minor Works Project

- 4.14 Some **1,681** new jobs will be created in 1999 and 2000 as a result of minor works projects. Of these, about 223 are at the professional/managerial levels, and 1,458 are at the operative/clerical levels. Major projects and their respective new jobs generated are as follows:
- (a) 1059 from Rural Public Works Programme;

- (b) 413 from Rural Planning and Improvement Strategy minor works programme;
- (c) 110 from the requirement of owners of man-made private slopes to rectify their substandard slopes; and
- (b) 99 for completing screening studies of underground services affecting 500 slopes per year.

Others

4.15 5,987 jobs (comprising 4,443 permanent and 1,544 project based jobs) are expected to be created in 1999 and 2000 in a wide range of other areas including Government property management, arts/sports/recreation, industrial safety, fire safety, urban planning, community services, land management and airport management and services.
