Amend the Dumping at Sea Ordinance.

Enacted by the Legislative Council.

- 1. Short title and commencement
 - (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Dumping at Sea (Amendment) Ordinance 2000.
- (2) This Ordinance shall come into operation on a day to be appointed by the Secretary for the Environment and Food by notice in the Gazette.
- Requirement to have permit for dumping at sea
 Section 8(2) of the Dumping at Sea Ordinance (Cap. 466) is repealed.

 Explanatory Memorandum

The purpose of this Bill is to repeal the provision in the Dumping at Sea Ordinance (Cap. 466) which exempts reclamation authorized under the Foreshore and Sea-bed (Reclamations) Ordinance (Cap. 127) from the requirement for a permit for dumping at sea. The relevant exemptions will be prescribed by the Secretary for the Environment and Food in accordance with the Dumping at Sea Ordinance (Cap. 466).
