Services meeting on 21st March, 2000, the Administration was asked to provide the

following information for the Panel.

(a) An analysis of the cost implications of prosecutions conducted by law

enforcement departments, and

(b) The number of departmental prosecutions in the law enforcement

departments mentioned in the Administration's paper.

2. The following are the answers to the above questions :

(a) In 1999, the cost of prosecutions conducted by prosecutors of the law

enforcement departments is estimated to be \$3,284 per day. This compares

to \$5,670 to \$8,530 per day if the prosecutions were conducted by counsel-

on-fiat.

(b) There were 207 departmental prosecutors in the law enforcement

departments in 1999.
