### Information Paper for LegCo Panel on Transport on Proposed Bus-Bus Interchange Schemes in 2000

#### **PURPOSE**

This paper presents for member's information the details of the Bus-Bus Interchange (BBI) Schemes targeted to be implemented in 2000.

#### **BACKGROUND**

- 2. At the Panel meeting on 26 May 2000, members requested for more information on the BBI schemes targeted to be implemented within 2000.
- 3. BBI schemes are developed to improve the bus network coverage for the benefits of the bus passengers, while at the same time reduce the pressure for new direct bus routes. Making use of the Octopus technology, fare discounts are offered by the franchised bus companies to encourage interchange. Seven BBI schemes are planned to be implemented in 2000.

#### THE BBI SCHEMES

- 4. Of the 7 schemes, the one at Kwun Tong Road involving 6 KMB routes was implemented on 26 March 2000. Passengers on Route 296A are offered a discount on the second leg of their journeys when they interchange with 5 other routes serving Kwai Shing, Sha Tin, Tai Po, Sheung Shui and Tin Shui Wai respectively.
- 5. According to the current programme, the next BBI scheme will be introduced in June 2000 at Western Harbour Tunnel Toll Plaza (Hong Kong bound). Under the scheme, passengers taking Citybus routes 930 (from Tsuen Wan), 962 (from Tuen Mun) and 969 (from Tin Shui Wai) to Hong Kong Island will be offered a discount when they interchange with route 973 to the Southern district.

- 6. Discussions with the franchised bus operators on the remaining schemes are continuing. The route details, fare discount arrangements and necessary software modifications are being worked out together with Creative Star. We plan to have the remaining schemes put into operation within 2000.
- 7. The Annex provides the summary on the latest development of each scheme.
