- (A) by repealing "Air Crewman Officer" and substituting "Air Crewman Officer I";
- (B) by repealing "Senior Air Crewman" and substituting "Air Crewman Officer II";
- (C) by repealing "Air Crewman" and substituting "Air Crewman Officer III";
 - (ii) in the entry relating to "Officer---Auxiliary"---
- (A) by adding "Air Medical Officer---Auxiliary" after "Air Traffic Controller---Auxiliary";
- (B) by repealing "Medical Nursing Officer---Auxiliary" and substituting "Air Medical Nursing Officer--- Auxiliary";
